1 AN ACT concerning appropriations.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented**
3 **in the General Assembly:**

4 ARTICLE 1

5 Section 5. The sum of \$11,059,900, or so much thereof as
6 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Dram Shop Fund to
7 the Liquor Control Commission for operational expenses of the
8 fiscal year ending June 30, 2023.

9 Section 10. The following named sums, or so much thereof
10 as may be necessary, respectively, for the objects and purposes
11 hereinafter named, are appropriated to the Liquor Control
12 Commission:

PAYABLE FROM DRAM SHOP FUND	
14	For Refunds5,000
15	For expenses related to the
16	Retailer Education Program263,200
17	For the purpose of operating the
