Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

Article 1

Section 10. The amount of \$195,000, or so much thereof as

21 may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue Fund

- and contingent expenses of the Expungement Program.
- 3 Section 15. The amount \$100,000, or so much thereof as may
- 4 be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue Fund to
- 5 the Office of the State Appellate Defender to provide statewide
- 6 training to Public Defenders under the Public Defender Training
- 7 Program.
- 8 Section 20. The amount of \$591,000, or so much thereof as
- 9 may be necessary, is appropriated from General Revenue Fund to
- 10 the Office of the State Appellate Defender to develop a Juvenile
- 11 Defender Resource Center.
- 12 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect July 1,
- 13 2022.
