**SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:**

ILCON Art. I, Sec. 22.1 new

Proposes to amend the Bill of Rights Article of the Illinois Constitution. Provides that the people have a right, which includes the right to use traditional methods, to hunt, fish, and harvest wildlife, subject only to the laws enacted to promote wildlife conservation and management and preserve the future of hunting and fishing. Provides that hunting and fishing shall be a preferred means of managing and controlling wildlife. Effective upon being declared adopted.

12                                   BILL OF RIGHTS

13           (ILCON Art. I, Sec. 22.1 new)

14   SECTION 22.1. RIGHT TO HUNT, FISH, AND HARVEST WILDLIFE

15       (a) The people have a right, which includes the right to  
16 use traditional methods, to hunt, fish, and harvest wildlife,  
17 subject only to the laws enacted to:

18           (1) promote wildlife conservation and management; and

19           (2) preserve the future of hunting and fishing.

20       (c) Hunting and fishing shall be a preferred means of  
21 managing and controlling wildlife.

22       (d) This Section shall not be construed to limit the  
23 application of any provision of law relating to trespass or

4 declared adopted in accordance with Section 7 of the Illinois
