- 2 WHEREAS, The members of the Illinois Senate are saddened 3 to learn of the death of Jesse J. Perez, who passed away on 4 November 27, 2020; and
- 5 WHEREAS, Jesse Perez was born in Moline to Jose and 6 Francisca (Cervantes) Perez on August 6, 1924; he served in 7 the U.S. Navy for 20 years and earned the rank of chief petty 8 officer; during his military service, he married Reiko Ida in 9 Sasebo, Nagasaki, Japan, and she preceded him in death in 10 February 2006; and
- 11 WHEREAS, Upon retiring from the U.S. Navy, Jesse Perez
 12 began his career at the Rock Island Arsenal and worked there
 13 for 30 years; and
 - WHEREAS, Jesse Perez was known for his generous heart, for sharing his wisdom, and for being an advocate for civil and humanitarian rights; he belonged to the American G.I. Forum, which is dedicated to addressing problems of discrimination and inequities endured by Hispanic veterans; he was a member of numerous community organizations, but he was especially committed to the Floreciente neighborhood; his love for the community was only surpassed by his love for family, especially his grandsons; he will be remembered for
