WHEREAS, Madeleine McAfee was born on September 27, 1956; she earned a Master of Business Administration from the University of Chicago; and

WHEREAS, Madeleine McAfee worked as an engineer and marketing manager at Motorola for mission-critical communications infrastructure products; and

WHEREAS, Madeleine McAfee volunteered with multiple organizations, including coaching Lombard Park District soccer and basketball from 1995 to 1998, serving as a den mother for the Cub Scouts from 1995 to 1999, serving with the People's Resource Center from 2005 to 2021, and assisting the Chicagoland Lab Rescue from 2015 to 2021, through which she fostered more than 60 dogs; after Hurricane Katrina, she traveled with the Willow Creek Church to Mississippi in August 2006 to assist with food banks, painting houses, debris removal, repairs, the construction of damaged homes, cooking, and serving other volunteers; she was involved with Girls on the Run (GOTR) from March to May 2016; she participated in five

2 raised more than \$12,000 for the fight against breast cancer,  
3 and ran five times in the Foodie 5k to benefit the Northern
