3 to learn of the death of Clarence Edward "Ed" Brummett of  
4 Jacksonville, who passed away on April 26, 2022; and

5           WHEREAS, Ed Brummett was born to Milford Collier and  
6 Bertha Lee Brummett in Lynnville on July 17, 1924; he served as  
7 a sergeant in the Anti-Tank Company, 330th Infantry,  
8 Thunderbolt Division of the U.S. Army during World War II,  
9 where he was involved in the Normandy Invasion and the Battle  
10 of the Bulge, with one and a half years of combat; he married  
11 Ruby Phyllis Francis on October 5, 1946, and they resided in  
12 Jacksonville for most of their lives before she preceded him  
13 in death on August 14, 2016; and

14           WHEREAS, Ed Brummett made his living as an Over the Road  
15 (OTR) semi truck driver; and

16           WHEREAS, Ed Brummett was preceded in death by his wife of  
17 69 years, Ruby Phyllis, and his siblings, Francis Loomis,  
18 Margaret Brummett, Nola Dehlin, John Brummett, and Wendell  
19 Brummett; and
