WHEREAS, Prior to his tenure with the Streamwood Park District, Mark Bell worked as a superintendent at Woodfield Mall in Schaumburg during the 1980s and 1990s, overseeing building maintenance and cleaning crews; and

WHEREAS, Mark Bell was an avid fan of the University of Michigan; he was very involved at his church, enjoyed golfing, and loved spending time with his family; alongside his wife, children, and grandchildren, he was a fixture at Streamwood
