2 AMENDMENT NO. \_\_\_\_\_. Amend House Bill 3, AS AMENDED, with  
3 reference to page and line numbers of House Amendment No. 5, on  
4 page 4, line 4, by replacing "and 7.3" with "7.3, and 9"; and

5 on page 17, by deleting lines 11 through 15; and

6 on page 17, immediately below line 22, by inserting the  
7 following:

8 "(325 ILCS 5/9) (from Ch. 23, par. 2059)

9 Sec. 9. Any person, institution or agency, under this Act,  
10 participating in good faith in the making of a report or  
11 referral, or in the investigation of such a report or referral  
12 or in the taking of photographs and x-rays or in the retaining  
13 a child in temporary protective custody or in making a  
14 disclosure of information concerning reports of child abuse  
15 and neglect in compliance with Sections 4.2 and 11.1 of this

1 Act or Section 4 of this Act, as it relates to disclosure by  
2 school personnel and except in cases of wilful or wanton  
3 misconduct, shall have immunity from any liability, civil,  
4 criminal or that otherwise might result by reason of such  
5 actions. For the purpose of any proceedings, civil or  
6 criminal, the good faith of any persons required to report or  
7 refer, or permitted to report, cases of suspected child abuse  
8 or neglect or permitted to refer individuals under this Act or  
9 required to disclose information concerning reports of child  
10 abuse and neglect in compliance with Sections 4.2 and 11.1 of  
11 this Act, shall be presumed. This presumption applies to a  
12 person who discloses information under subsection (b-1) of  
13 Section 7.3 only for one year after the effective date of this  
14 amendatory Act of the 103rd General Assembly. One year after  
15 the effective date of this amendatory Act of the 103rd General  
16 Assembly, this presumption may not apply to any person who  
17 violates subsection (b-1) of Section 7.3. For purposes of this  
18 Section "child abuse and neglect" includes abuse or neglect of  
19 an adult resident as defined in this Act.
