1 AN ACT concerning civil law.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. The Wrongful Death Act is amended by changing

 Section 1 as follows:
- 6 (740 ILCS 180/1) (from Ch. 70, par. 1)
- 7 (Text of Section WITHOUT the changes made by P.A. 89-7,
- 8 which has been held unconstitutional)
- 9 Sec. 1. Whenever the death of a person shall be caused by
- 10 wrongful act, neglect or default, and the act, neglect or
- 11 default is such as would, if death had not ensued, have
- 12 entitled the party injured to maintain an action and recover
- damages, including punitive damages, in respect thereof, then
- and in every such case the person who or company or corporation
- which would have been liable if death had not ensued, shall be
- liable to an action for damages, <u>including punitive damages</u>,
- 17 notwithstanding the death of the person injured, and although
- 18 the death shall have been caused under such circumstances as
- 19 amount in law to felony.
