1 AMENDMENT TO HOUSE BILL 308

2 AMENDMENT NO. _____. Amend House Bill 308 by replacing
3 everything after the enacting clause with the following:

4 "Section 5. The Interscholastic Athletic Organization Act
5 is amended by changing Section 1 as follows:

6 (105 ILCS 25/1) (from Ch. 122, par. 1821)

7 Sec. 1. Membership; governance.

8 (a) No membership or other dues or fees shall be paid by
9 the governing body of any public elementary or public
10 secondary school in this State to any association or other
11 entity which has as one of its purposes promoting, sponsoring,
12 regulating or in any manner providing for interscholastic
13 athletics or any form of athletic competition among schools
14 and students within this State if such association or other
15 entity adopts or maintains in effect any bylaw, rule,
16 regulation or policy which designates or requires a member to

1 designate its school principal or any other school
2 administrator as the representative of the member who alone is
3 entitled to cast the vote of the member on any matter coming
4 before such association or entity which is to be determined by
5 a vote of its general membership; provided, that the
6 provisions of this Section shall not apply if the bylaws,
7 rules, regulations or policies of such association or entity,
8 as adopted and applied: (i) authorize the governing board of
9 each secondary school which is a member of the association or
10 entity to appoint, as the allotted representative of such
11 secondary school entitled to cast its vote on any matter
12 coming before the association or entity which is to be
13 determined by a vote of its general membership, any coach,
14 athletic director, teacher, principal or other school
15 administrator employed at the secondary school which the
16 governing body chooses to appoint as such representative, and
17 (ii) provide that if no representative of a member is so
18 appointed by its governing body, that the school principal of
19 the member shall be its representative authorized to cast its
20 vote unless and until the governing body shall otherwise
21 appoint.

22 (b) An association or other entity that has as one of its
23 purposes promoting, sponsoring, regulating or in any manner
24 providing for interscholastic athletics, or any form of
25 athletic competition among schools and students within this
26 State shall establish an executive board of the association or

1 other entity that shall be filled by public school
2 superintendents who are currently employed by a public school
3 district with a high school. The members of the executive
4 board shall be elected on a regionally representative basis
5 using maps developed by the Illinois Association of School
6 Administrators, Illinois Association of School Boards, and the
7 Illinois Principals Association. Members of the executive
8 board shall be initially elected as follows:

9 (1) one-third of seats shall be elected to a one-year
10 term;

11 (2) one-third of seats shall be elected to a 2-year
12 term; and

13 (3) one-third of seats shall be elected to a 3-year
14 term.

15 After the initial elections, each member shall be elected
16 to a 3-year terms. The first election shall occur before
17 December 1, 2024. The terms of the executive board shall begin
18 on January 1, 2025.
