4 Section 5. The Illinois Act on the Aging is amended by 5 adding Section 8.13 as follows:

Sec. 8.13. Grandparents Raising Grandchildren Pilot
Program.

9 The Department shall establish and administer a (a) Grandparents Raising Grandchildren Pilot Program to operate in 10 Will County beginning January 1, 2024 through January 1, 2027. 11 12 The pilot program shall allow the Senior Services Center of Will County to designate an intake coordinator for Will County 13 14 who shall help connect grandparents raising grandchildren to relevant services and resources provided by the various State 15 agencies, including, but not limited to, services and 16 17 resources provided by the Department of Children and Family Services, the Department of Human Services, the Department on 18 19 Aging, the Department of Healthcare and Family Services, and the State Board of Education. The intake coordinator shall 20 21 provide services at local Senior Services Centers located in 22 Will County and shall work with the Department on Aging to create a public awareness campaign on the services and 23

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1 resources offered by each of the agencies. The intake 2 coordinator selected by the Department on Aging must be 3 knowledgeable on the following programs:

4 <u>(1) The Extended Family Support Program administered</u> 5 <u>by the Department of Children and Family Services.</u>

6 <u>(2) The Grandparents Raising Grandchildren Program</u> 7 <u>administered by the Department on Aging.</u>

8 <u>(3) The Child Only Grants assistance component of the</u> 9 <u>Temporary Assistance for Needy Families program</u> 10 <u>administered by the Department of Human Services.</u>

11(4) The Children Health Insurance Program administered12by the Department of Healthcare and Family Services.

13 (b) The intake coordinator must be given the contact 14 information for the designated point of contact for each State agency listed in subsection (a). Each State agency's 15 16 designated point of contact shall provide educational 17 materials and training on the different programs provided by the State agency. The intake coordinator may receive this 18 19 information within 14 days after his or her selection by the 20 Department on Aging in accordance with this Section.

(c) By January 1 of each year beginning in 2025 until the pilot program terminates, the Department on Aging shall submit an annual report to the General Assembly on the number of families who received referrals to relevant services from the intake coordinator during the prior calendar year, the specific services each family was referred to and received, HB0780 Engrossed - 3 - LRB103 04372 RPS 49378 b
