

103RD GENERAL ASSEMBLY State of Illinois 2023 and 2024 HB1160

SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

430 ILCS 68/5-70

Amends the Firearm Dealer License Certification Act. Provides that the fee amount for a certified licensee shall be based upon the number of firearms sold per year. Provides that if the certified licensee sells less than 150,000 firearms per year, the fee is \$200. Provides that if the certified licensee sells 150,000 to 500,000 firearms per year, the fee is \$500. Provides that if the certified licensee sells over 500,000 firearms per year, the fee is \$1,000.

1 AN ACT concerning criminal law.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

Section 5. The Firearm Dealer License Certification Act is amended by changing Section 5-70 as follows:

Sec. 5-70. Fees and fines deposited in the State Police Firearm Services Fund. The Illinois State Police shall set and collect a fee for each licensee certifying under this Act. The fee amount for a certified licensee shall be based upon the number of firearms sold per year. If the certified licensee sells less than 150,000 firearms per year, the fee is \$200. If the certified licensee sells 150,000 to 500,000 firearms per year, the fee is \$500. If the certified licensee sells over 500,000 firearms per year, the fee is \$1,000. The fee may not exceed \$300 for a certified licensee operating without retail location. The fee may not exceed \$1,500 for certified licensee operating with a retail location. The Illinois State Police may not charge a certified licensee in this State, operating under the same or different business name, fees exceeding \$40,000 for the certification of multiple licenses. All fees and fines collected under this Act shall be deposited in the State Police Firearm Services Fund. Moneys in
