SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

110 ILCS 947/23 new

Amends the Higher Education Student Assistance Act. Requires the Illinois Student Assistance Commission to implement and administer a program, beginning with the 2023-2024 academic year, to award grants to Illinois residents seeking a associate degree, certificate, or diploma from a public community college. Sets forth the terms and conditions of the program. Effective immediately.

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AN ACT concerning education.

2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, 3 represented in the General Assembly:

Section 5. The Higher Education Student Assistance Act is
amended by adding Section 23 as follows:

6 (110 ILCS 947/23 new)

7	Sec. 23. Public community college tuition grant program.
8	(a) The Commission shall implement and administer a
9	program, beginning with the 2023-2024 academic year, to award
10	grants to all eligible Illinois residents seeking a associate
11	degree, certificate, or diploma from a public community
12	college. The following terms and conditions shall apply to the
13	program:
14	(1) To be eligible for a grant, a student must be
15	admitted to and enrolled as a Illinois resident in a
16	public community college.
17	(2) Students applying for a grant shall complete the

18grant application in their initial year of enrollment.19Students shall complete the Free Application for Federal20Student Aid each academic year in which they seek to21receive a grant.

22 (3) To continue to receive a grant, a student must
 23 <u>maintain Illinois residency.</u>

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1	(4) Each academic year, subject to appropriation, a
2	grant shall be equal to the cost of tuition and mandatory
3	fees at the public community college.
4	(5) A student awarded a grant who has an approved
5	medical or personal leave of absence from a public
6	community college may continue to receive the grant upon
7	resuming the student's education at a public community
8	college so long as the student continues to meet all
9	applicable eligibility requirements under this Section and
10	as adopted by the Commission.
11	(6) A student is eligible for a grant until the
12	student has earned an associate degree, certificate, or
13	diploma from a public community college.
14	(b) The Commission may adopt any rules necessary to
15	implement this Section.
16	Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect upon
17	becoming law.
