Amends the Code of Civil Procedure. Makes a technical change in provisions concerning sealing of court files in an eviction action.

- 7 Sec. 9-121. Sealing of court file.
- 8 (a) Definition. As used in this Section, "court file" 9 means the the court file created when an eviction action is
 - (b) Discretionary sealing of court file. The court may order that a court file in an eviction action be placed under seal if the court finds that the plaintiff's action is sufficiently without a basis in fact or law, which may include a lack of jurisdiction, that placing the court file under seal is clearly in the interests of justice, and that those interests are not outweighed by the public's interest in knowing about the record.
- 19 (c) Mandatory sealing of court file. The court file 20 relating to an eviction action brought against a tenant under 21 Section 9-207.5 of this Code or as set forth in subdivision 22 (h)(6) of Section 15-1701 of this Code shall be placed under 23 seal.

- 1 (d) This Section is operative on and after August 1, 2022.
