## Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

Section 5. The School Code is amended by changing Section
27-17 as follows:

(105 ILCS 5/27-17) (from Ch. 122, par. 27-17) 6 Sec. 27-17. Safety education. School boards of public 7 schools and all boards in charge of educational institutions 8 9 supported wholly or partially by the State may provide instruction in safety education in all grades and include such 10 instruction in the courses of study regularly taught therein. 11 In this Section, section "safety education" means and 12 includes instruction in the following: 13 14 1. automobile safety, including traffic regulations, 15 highway safety, and the consequences of alcohol 16 consumption and the operation of a motor vehicle; 17 2. safety in the home, including safe gun storage; 3. safety in connection with recreational activities; 18 19 4. safety in and around school buildings; 5. safety in connection with vocational work or 20 21 training; 22 6. cardio-pulmonary resuscitation for students enrolled in grades 9 through 11; and 23

7. for students enrolled in grades 6 through 8,
 cardio-pulmonary resuscitation and how to use an automated
 external defibrillator by watching a training video on
 those subjects; and-

5 <u>8. for students enrolled in prekindergarten through</u>
6 grade 6, water safety that incorporates evidence-based
7 water safety instructional materials and resources.

8 Such boards may make suitable provisions in the schools 9 and institutions under their jurisdiction for instruction in 10 safety education for not less than 16 hours during each school 11 year.

12 curriculum in all educator preparation programs The approved by the State Educator Preparation and Licensure Board 13 shall contain instruction in safety education for teachers 14 15 that is appropriate to the grade level of the educator 16 license. This instruction may be by specific courses in safety 17 education or may be incorporated in existing subjects taught in the educator preparation program. 18
