

## 103RD GENERAL ASSEMBLY State of Illinois 2023 and 2024 HB2168

## SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

105 ILCS 5/10-20.85 new 105 ILCS 5/34-18.82 new

Amends the School Code. Provides that a school board of a school district with 275,000 students or more shall prohibit any school of the district that has selective admission requirements from requiring a student in a pre-kindergarten program of the district to take a standardized test in order to be admitted to that school. Effective immediately.

## Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. The School Code is amended by adding Sections 10-20.85 and 34-18.82 as follows:
- 6 (105 ILCS 5/10-20.85 new)
- 7 <u>Sec. 10-20.85. Selective admissions; standardized testing.</u>
- 8 A school board in a school district with 275,000 students or
- 9 more shall prohibit any school of the district that has
- 10 <u>selective admission requirements from requiring a student in a</u>
- 11 pre-kindergarten program of the district to take a
- 12 standardized test in order to be admitted to that school.
- 13 (105 ILCS 5/34-18.82 new)
- 14 Sec. 34-18.82. Selective admissions; standardized testing.
- 15 The board shall prohibit any school of the district that has
- 16 selective admission requirements from requiring a student in a
- 17 pre-kindergarten program of the district to take a
- 18 <u>standardized test in order to be admitted to that school.</u>
- 19 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect upon
- 20 becoming law.
