1 AN ACT concerning regulation.

## Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- 4 Section 1. Short title. This Act may be cited as the Access
- 5 to Affordable Insulin Act.
- 6 Section 5. Definitions. As used in this Act:
- 7 "Department" means the Department of Central Management
- 8 Services.
- 9 "Director" means the Director of Central Management
- 10 Services.
- "Insulin" means a prescription drug that contains insulin.
- 12 "Manufacturer" means a manufacturer engaged in the
- 13 manufacturing of insulin that is self-administered on an
- 14 outpatient basis.
- 15 "Navigator" has the meaning described in Section 1311(i)
- 16 of the Patient Protection and Affordable Care Act, Public Law
- 17 111-148, and further defined through amendments to that Act
- and regulations issued under that Act.
- "Pharmacy" means a pharmacy located in this State.
- 20 "Prescription drug" means a drug that is required by
- 21 federal or State law or rule to be dispensed only by
- 22 prescription or that is restricted to administration only by
- 23 practitioners.

- 1 Section 10. Insulin discount program.
- 2 (a) The Department shall offer a discount program that
- 3 allows participants to purchase insulin at a discounted,
- 4 post-rebate price.
- 5 (b) The discount program shall:
- 6 (1) provide a participant with a card or electronic
- 7 document that identifies the participant as eligible for
- 8 the discount;
- 9 (2) provide a participant with information about
- 10 pharmacies that will honor the discount;
- 11 (3) allow a participant to purchase insulin at a
- 12 discounted, post-rebate price; and
- 13 (4) provide a participant with instructions to pursue
- 14 a reimbursement of the purchase price from the
- participant's health insurer.
- 16 (c) The discount program shall charge a price for insulin
- 17 that allows the program to retain only enough of any rebate for
- 18 the insulin to make the State risk pool whole for providing
- 19 discounted insulin to participants.
- Section 90. The Illinois Insurance Code is amended by
- 21 changing Section 356z.41 as follows:
- 22 (215 ILCS 5/356z.41)
- 23 Sec. 356z.41. Cost sharing in prescription insulin drugs;

- 1 limits; confidentiality of rebate information.
- 2 (a) As used in this Section, "prescription insulin drug"
- 3 means a prescription drug that contains insulin and is used to
- 4 control blood glucose levels to treat diabetes but does not
- 5 include an insulin drug that is administered to a patient
- 6 intravenously.
- 7 (b) This Section applies to a group or individual policy
- 8 of accident and health insurance amended, delivered, issued,
- 9 or renewed on or after the effective date of this amendatory
- 10 Act of the 101st General Assembly.
- 11 (c) An insurer that provides coverage for prescription
- insulin drugs pursuant to the terms of a health coverage plan
- 13 the insurer offers shall limit the total amount that an
- insured is required to pay for a 30-day supply of covered
- prescription insulin drugs at an amount not to exceed \$35
- 16 \$100, regardless of the quantity or type of covered
- 17 prescription insulin drug used to fill the insured's
- 18 prescription.
- 19 (d) Nothing in this Section prevents an insurer from
- 20 reducing an insured's cost sharing by an amount greater than
- 21 the amount specified in subsection (c).
- (e) The Director may use any of the Director's enforcement
- powers to obtain an insurer's compliance with this Section.
- 24 (f) The Department may adopt rules as necessary to
- 25 implement and administer this Section and to align it with
- 26 federal requirements.

- 1 (g) On January 1 of each year, the limit on the amount that
- 2 an insured is required to pay for a 30-day supply of a covered
- 3 prescription insulin drug shall increase by a percentage equal
- 4 to the percentage change from the preceding year in the
- 5 medical care component of the Consumer Price Index of the
- 6 Bureau of Labor Statistics of the United States Department of
- 7 Labor.
