Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. The Clinical Social Work and Social Work

 Practice Act is amended by changing Sections 5 and 9 and by

 adding Section 8.2 as follows:

- 8 (Section scheduled to be repealed on January 1, 2028)
- 9 Sec. 5. Powers and duties of the Department. Subject to 10 the provisions of this Act, the Department shall exercise the 11 following functions, powers, and duties:
 - (1) Conduct or authorize examinations or examination alternatives to ascertain the qualifications and fitness of candidates for a license to engage in the independent practice of clinical social work, pass upon the qualifications of applicants for licenses, and issue licenses to those who are found to be fit and qualified.
 - (2) Adopt rules required for the administration and enforcement of this Act.
 - (3) Adopt rules for determining approved undergraduate and graduate social work degree programs and prepare and maintain a list of colleges and universities offering such approved programs whose graduates, if they otherwise meet

- the requirements of this Act, are eligible to apply for a 1 2 license.
- Prescribe forms 3 (4)to be issued for the administration and enforcement of this Act consistent with 4 and reflecting the requirements of this Act and rules adopted pursuant to this Act. 6
- 7 (5) Conduct investigations related to possible violations of this Act. 8
- (6) Maintain rosters of the names and addresses of all 9 persons who hold valid licenses under this Act. These 10 11 rosters shall be available upon written request and 12 payment of the required fee.

- 16 (a) An applicant may use an examination alternative to allow the Department to ascertain the qualifications and 17 18 fitness of candidates for a license to engage in the independent practice of clinical social work. 19
- 20 (b) The examination alternative shall consist of at least 21 3,000 hours of supervised professional experience that is 22 obtained within the 10 calendar years immediately preceding 23 the date of application and after the degree is obtained as 24 established by rule. If no supervision by a licensed clinical social worker is available, then supervised professional 25

- disciplines as defined by rule.
- 3 <u>(c) The examination alternative supervised professional</u>
- 4 <u>experience shall be in addition to any other supervised</u>

- 13 Sec. 9. Oualifications for clinical social worker license.
- 14 A person shall be qualified to be licensed as a clinical social
- worker if that person:
- 16 (1) has applied in writing on the prescribed form;
- 17 (2) is of good moral character. In determining good
- 18 moral character, the Department may take into
- 19 consideration whether the applicant was engaged in conduct
- or actions that would constitute grounds for discipline
- 21 under this Act;
- 22 (3)(a) demonstrates to the satisfaction of the
- Department that subsequent to securing a master's degree
- in social work from an approved program the applicant has
- 25 successfully completed at least 3,000 hours of

- (b) demonstrates to the satisfaction of the Department that such applicant has received a doctor's degree in social work from an approved program and has completed at least 2,000 hours of satisfactory, supervised clinical professional experience subsequent to the degree;
- (4) has passed the examination for the practice of clinical social work as authorized by the Department or has completed the examination alternative set forth in Section 8.2; and
- 12 (5) has paid the required fees.
