SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

225 ILCS 150/10

Amends the Telehealth Act. Provides that a health care professional may treat a patient located in another state if the patient is a student attending an out-of-state institution of higher education but is otherwise a resident in the State when not attending the institution of higher education.

AN ACT concerning regulation. 1

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, 2 represented in the General Assembly: 3

- 4 Section 5. The Telehealth Act is amended by changing 5 Section 10 as follows:
- (225 ILCS 150/10) 6
- 7 Sec. 10. Practice authority. A health care professional 8 treating a patient located in this State through telehealth 9 services must be licensed or authorized to practice in Illinois. A health care professional with a temporary permit 10 for full practice advanced practice registered nurse for 11 health care, a temporary permit for advanced practice 12 registered nurse for health care, or a temporary permit for 13 14 health care may treat a patient located in this State through telehealth services in a manner consistent with the health 15 16 care professional's scope of practice and agreement with a 17 sponsoring entity.
 - A health care professional may treat a patient located in another state if the patient is a student attending an out-of-state institution of higher education but is otherwise a resident in the State when not attending the institution of higher education.
