- 7 Sec. 10. Practice authority. A health care professional 8 treating a patient located in this State through telehealth 9 services must be licensed or authorized to practice in Illinois. A health care professional with a temporary permit 10 for full practice advanced practice registered nurse for 11 health care, a temporary permit for advanced practice 12 registered nurse for health care, or a temporary permit for 13 14 health care may treat a patient located in this State through telehealth services in a manner consistent with the health 15 16 care professional's scope of practice and agreement with a 17 sponsoring entity.
 - An out-of-state health care professional may treat a patient located in this State through telehealth if the patient is a student attending an institution of higher education in this State, but is otherwise not a resident of the State when not attending the institution of higher education.
