A BILL FOR

AN ACT concerning appropriations.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

ARTICLE 1

5 Section 1. The sum of \$700,000 or so much thereof as may 6 be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue Fund to 7 the Deaf and Hard of Hearing Commission for operational 8 expenses of the fiscal year ending June 30, 2024.

9 Section 5. The sum of \$247,500, or so much thereof as may 10 be necessary, is appropriated from the Interpreters for the 11 Deaf Fund to the Deaf and Hard of Hearing Commission for 12 administration and enforcement of the Interpreter for the Deaf 13 Licensure Act of 2007.

Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect July 1, 2023.
