Makes appropriations for the ordinary and contingent expenses of the Law Enforcement Training Standards Board for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2023, as follows:

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

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ARTICLE 1

Section 20. The amount of \$10,000,000, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue Fund to the Law Enforcement Training Standards Board for deposit into the Law Enforcement Recruitment and Retention Fund for grants and administrative expenses to hire or retain law enforcement officers pursuant to Public Act 102-755.

Section 25. The amount of \$10,000,000, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Law Enforcement Recruitment and Retention Fund to the Law Enforcement Training Standards Board for grants and administrative expenses to hire or retain law enforcement officers pursuant to Public Act 102-12 755

Section 30. The amount of \$30,000,000, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue Fund to the Law Enforcement Training Standards Board for deposit into the Law Enforcement Camera Grant Fund.

The amount of \$4,000,000, or so much thereof 18 as may be necessary, is appropriated from General Revenue Fund 19 to the Law Enforcement Training Standards Board for grants to 20 local law enforcement agencies for costs associated with the 21 expansion and support of National Integrated Ballistics 22 Information Network (NIBIN) and other ballistic technology
