SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

35 ILCS 5/234 new

Amends the Illinois Income Tax Act. Creates a credit for taxpayers that install an electric vehicle charging station at a business location in the State during the taxable year and use a contractor that participates in an apprenticeship program for the installation. Effective immediately.

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AN ACT concerning revenue.

2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, 3 represented in the General Assembly:

4 Section 5. The Illinois Income Tax Act is amended by 5 adding Section 234 as follows:

6 (35 ILCS 5/234 new)

7 Sec. 234. Electric vehicle charging stations.

(a) For taxable years beginning on or after January 1, 8 9 2024, each taxpayer that installs an electric vehicle charging station at a business location in the State during the taxable 10 year and uses a contractor that participates in an 11 12 apprenticeship program for the installation is entitled to a credit against the taxes imposed by subsections (a) and (b) of 13 14 Section 201 in an amount equal to the amount spent by the taxpayer on the installation of the charging station. 15

16 (b) In no event shall a credit under this Section reduce the taxpayer's liability to less than zero. If the amount of 17 the credit exceeds the tax liability for the year, the excess 18 19 may be carried forward and applied to the tax liability of the 5 taxable years following the excess credit year. The tax 20 21 credit shall be applied to the earliest year for which there is 22 a tax liability. If there are credits for more than one year that are available to offset a liability, the earlier credit 23
