## SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

10 ILCS 5/11-8

Amends the Election Code. Provides that election authorities may (rather than shall) establish at least one location to be located at an office of the election authority or in the largest municipality within its jurisdiction where all voters in its jurisdiction are allowed to vote on election day during polling place hours, regardless of the precinct in which they are registered. Removes language repealing the provisions on July 1, 2023. Makes a conforming change. Effective immediately.

AN ACT concerning elections.

## Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

Section 5. The Election Code is amended by changing Section 11-8 as follows:
(10 ILCS 5/11-8)
(Section scheduled to be repealed on July 1, 2023)
Sec. 11-8. Vote centers.
(a) Notwithstanding any law to the contrary, election authorities may shall establish at least one location to be located at an office of the election authority or in the largest municipality within its jurisdiction where all voters in its jurisdiction are allowed to vote on election day during polling place hours, regardless of the precinct in which they are registered. An election authority establishing such a tocation under this section shall identify the loeation and any health and safety requirements by the 40 th day preceding the 2022 genexal primary election and the 2022 genexal election and certify such to the state Board of flections.
(b) (Blank) This Section is repealed on July 1, 2023.
