### SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

15 ILCS 505/18 30 ILCS 105/5.397 30 ILCS 212/10

Amends the State Treasurer Act. Makes changes concerning banking and teller machine services. Provides that the State Comptroller shall direct and the State Treasurer shall transfer the remaining balance from the Treasurer's Rental Fee Fund into the State Treasurer's Bank Services Trust Fund.

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AN ACT concerning State government.

# 2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, 3 represented in the General Assembly:

Section 5. The State Treasurer Act is amended by changing
Section 18 as follows:

6 (15 ILCS 505/18)

Sec. 18. Banking and <u>automated</u> <del>automatic</del> teller machine
services.

9 (a) The Treasurer may enter into written agreements with financial institutions for the provision of banking services 10 at the State Capitol and with automated teller machine 11 12 providers for the provision of automated automatic teller machine services at State office buildings, State parks, State 13 14 tourism centers, and State fairs at Springfield and DuQuoin. The Treasurer shall establish competitive procedures for the 15 16 selection of financial institutions and automated teller 17 machine providers to provide the services authorized under this Section. No State agency may procure services authorized 18 19 by this Section without the approval of the Treasurer.

20 (b) The Treasurer shall enter into written agreements with 21 the authorities having jurisdiction of the property where the 22 services are intended to be provided. These agreements shall 23 include, but need not be limited to, the quantity of machines to be located at the property and the exact location of the service or machine and shall establish responsibility for payment of expenses incurred in locating the machine or service.

5 (c) The Treasurer's agreement with a financial institution 6 <u>or automated teller machine providers</u> may authorize the 7 financial institution <u>or automated teller machine providers</u> to 8 provide any or all of the banking services that the financial 9 institution <u>or automated teller machine providers</u> is otherwise 10 authorized by law to provide to the public.

11 The Treasurer's agreement with a financial institution or 12 automated teller machine providers shall establish the amount 13 of compensation to be paid by the financial institution. The financial institution or automated teller machine providers 14 15 shall pay the compensation to the Treasurer in accordance with 16 the terms of the agreement. The Treasurer shall deposit moneys 17 received under this Section into the State Treasurer's Bank Services Trust Fund. Treasurer's Rental Fee Fund, a special 18 19 fund hereby created in the State treasury. The Treasurer shall 20 use the moneys in the Fund for the operation of the program established under this Section. If the Treasurer determines 21 22 that any moneys in the Treasurer's Rental Fee Fund are in 23 excess of the amount necessary to sustain the operation of the program established under this Section, the Treasurer may 24 25 transfer any unobligated and unexpended moneys from the Treasurer's Rental Fee Fund into the State Pensions Fund. 26

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(d) This Section does not apply to a State office building
 in which a currency exchange or a credit union providing
 financial services located in the building on July 1, 1995
 (the effective date of Public Act 88-640) is operating.

5 (e) Notwithstanding any other provision of law to the contrary, and in addition to any other transfers that may be 6 provided by law, within 30 days of the effective date of this 7 amendatory Act of the 103rd General Assembly, or as soon 8 9 thereafter as practicable, the State Comptroller shall direct 10 and the State Treasurer shall transfer the remaining balance 11 from the Treasurer's Rental Fee Fund into the State 12 Treasurer's Bank Services Trust Fund. Upon completion of the transfer, the Treasurer's Rental Fee Fund is dissolved, and 13 14 any future deposits due to that Fund and any outstanding obligations or liabilities of that Fund shall pass to the 15 16 State Treasurer's Bank Services Trust Fund.

18 Section 10. The State Finance Act is amended by changing 19 Section 5.397 as follows:

 Sec. 5.397. The Treasurer's Rental Fee Fund. <u>This Fund is</u>
 <u>dissolved upon the transfer of the remaining balance from the</u>
 <u>Treasurer's Rental Fee Fund to the State Treasurer's Bank</u>
 <u>Services Trust Fund as provided under subsection (e) of</u>

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# <u>Section 18 of the State Treasurer Act. This Section is</u> repealed on January 1, 2025.

Section 15. The State Treasurer's Bank Services Trust Fund
Act is amended by changing Section 10 as follows:

6 (30 ILCS 212/10)

7 Sec. 10. Creation of Fund. There is hereby created in the 8 State treasury a special fund to be known as the State 9 Treasurer's Bank Services Trust Fund. Moneys deposited in the 10 Fund shall be used by the State Treasurer to pay the cost of 11 the following banking services: processing of payments of 12 taxes, fees, and other moneys due the State; transactional, technological, consultant, legal service charges, and other 13 14 operational expenses of the State Treasurer's Office related 15 investment or safekeeping of funds under to the the Treasurer's control; the provision of banking and automated 16 17 teller machine services at State office buildings, State parks, State tourism centers, and State fairs at Springfield 18 19 and DuQuoin; and the cost of paying bondholders and legal 20 services under the State's general obligation bond program.
