

## 103RD GENERAL ASSEMBLY State of Illinois 2023 and 2024 HB2976

## SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

20 ILCS 2505/2505-810 new

Amends the Department of Revenue Law of the Civil Administrative Code of Illinois. Provides that the Department of Revenue shall not require a taxpayer, whether an individual, not-for-profit, or business entity, to collect and furnish to the Department individual tax identification information from vendors that participate in an event hosted or sponsored by the taxpayer. Effective immediately.

## Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- 4 Section 5. The Department of Revenue Law of the Civil
- 5 Administrative Code of Illinois is amended by adding Section
- 6 2505-810 as follows:

- 8 Sec. 2505-810. Collection of individualized tax
- 9 identification data. The Department shall not require a
- 10 taxpayer, whether an individual, not-for-profit, or business
- 11 entity, to collect and furnish to the Department individual
- 12 tax identification information from vendors that participate
- in an event hosted or sponsored by the taxpayer.
