1 AMENDMENT TO HOUSE BILL 3100

2 AMENDMENT NO. _____. Amend House Bill 3100 on page 1, by
3 replacing line 5 with "changing Sections 7-201, 7-201.1,
4 11-407, and 11-408 as follows:

5 (625 ILCS 5/7-201) (from Ch. 95 1/2, par. 7-201)

6 (Text of Section before amendment by P.A. 102-982)

7 Sec. 7-201. Application of Article II. The Administrator
8 as soon as practicable after the receipt of the report,
9 required to be filed under Sections 11-406 and 11-410, of a
10 motor vehicle accident occurring within this State and that
11 has resulted in bodily injury or death of any person or that
12 damage to the property of any one person in excess of \$1,500
13 (or \$500 if any of the vehicles involved in the accident is
14 subject to Section 7-601 but is not covered by a liability
15 insurance policy in accordance with Section 7-601) was
16 sustained, shall determine:

17 1. Whether Section 7-202 of this Code requires the

1 deposit of security by or on behalf of any person who was
2 the operator or owner of any motor vehicle in any manner
3 involved in the accident; and

4 2. What amount of security shall be sufficient to
5 satisfy any potential judgment or judgments for money
6 damages resulting from the accident as may be recovered
7 against the operator or owner, which amount shall in no
8 event be less than \$1,500 (or \$500 if any of the vehicles
9 involved in the accident is subject to Section 7-601 but
10 is not covered by a liability insurance policy in
11 accordance with Section 7-601).

14 Sec. 7-201. Application of Article II. The Administrator
15 as soon as practicable after the receipt of the report,
16 required to be filed under Section ~~Sections 11-406 and~~ 11-410,
17 of a motor vehicle crash occurring within this State and that
18 has resulted in bodily injury or death of any person or that
19 damage to the property of any one person in excess of \$1,500
20 (or \$500 if any of the vehicles involved in the crash is
21 subject to Section 7-601 but is not covered by a liability
22 insurance policy in accordance with Section 7-601) was
23 sustained, shall determine:

24 1. Whether Section 7-202 of this Code requires the
25 deposit of security by or on behalf of any person who was

1 the operator or owner of any motor vehicle in any manner
2 involved in the crash; and

3 2. What amount of security shall be sufficient to
4 satisfy any potential judgment or judgments for money
5 damages resulting from the crash as may be recovered
6 against the operator or owner, which amount shall in no
7 event be less than \$1,500 (or \$500 if any of the vehicles
8 involved in the crash is subject to Section 7-601 but is
9 not covered by a liability insurance policy in accordance
10 with Section 7-601).

13 (Text of Section before amendment by P.A. 102-982)

14 Sec. 7-201.1. If the Administrator has not received a
15 report required to be filed under Sections 11-406 and 11-410,
16 or if the information contained in a report is insufficient,
17 the Administrator shall send to the person required to file
18 the report a written request for the missing report or the
19 missing information. The Administrator shall send such request
20 no later than 45 days after the accident or 7 days after
21 receiving information that such accident has occurred,
22 whichever is later.

23 If the request is sent to a driver involved in an accident,
24 the request or an attachment thereto shall contain in bold
25 print a warning that failure to comply with the request within

1 15 days may result in the suspension of the driver's license.

3 (Text of Section after amendment by P.A. 102-982)

4 Sec. 7-201.1. If the Administrator has not received a
5 report required to be filed under Section ~~Sections 11-406 and~~
6 ~~11-410~~, or if the information contained in a report is
7 insufficient, the Administrator shall send to the person
8 required to file the report a written request for the missing
9 report or the missing information. The Administrator shall
10 send such request no later than 45 days after the crash or 7
11 days after receiving information that such crash has occurred,
12 whichever is later.

13 If the request is sent to a driver involved in a crash, the
14 request or an attachment thereto shall contain in bold print a
15 warning that failure to comply with the request within 15 days
16 may result in the suspension of the driver's license.

18 on page 2, by replacing line 6 with "excess of \$2,500 (or \$500
19 if any of the vehicles involved in"; and

20 on page 3, lines 7 and 8, by replacing "deer or other animal"
21 with "wild animal owned by the State of Illinois"; and

22 on page 9, immediately above line 7, by inserting the

1 following:

2 "Section 95. No acceleration or delay. Where this Act
3 makes changes in a statute that is represented in this Act by
4 text that is not yet or no longer in effect (for example, a
5 Section represented by multiple versions), the use of that
6 text does not accelerate or delay the taking effect of (i) the
7 changes made by this Act or (ii) provisions derived from any
8 other Public Act."
