SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

50 ILCS 825/5

Amends the Rent Control Preemption Act. Provides that the Act does not prohibit a municipality from setting rent controls for manufactured homes.

- 2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,
- 3 represented in the General Assembly:
- 4 Section 5. The Rent Control Preemption Act is amended by
- 5 changing Section 5 as follows:
- 6 (50 ILCS 825/5)
- 7 Sec. 5. Rent control prohibited.
- 8 (a) A unit of local government, as defined in Section 1 of
- 9 Article VII of the Illinois Constitution, shall not enact,
- 10 maintain, or enforce an ordinance or resolution that would
- 11 have the effect of controlling the amount of rent charged for
- leasing private residential or commercial property.
- 13 (b) This Act does not impair the right of a unit of local
- 14 government to manage and control residential property in which
- the unit of local government has a property interest.
- 16 (c) This Act does not prohibit a municipality from setting
- 17 rent controls for manufactured homes.
