1 AN ACT concerning transportation.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. The Illinois Vehicle Code is amended by changing Section 3-118 as follows:
- 6 (625 ILCS 5/3-118) (from Ch. 95 1/2, par. 3-118)
- Sec. 3-118. Application for salvage or junking certificate; contents.
- 9 (a) An application for a salvage certificate or junking 10 certificate shall be made upon the forms prescribed by the 11 Secretary of State and contain:
- 12 1. The name and address of the owner;
- 2. A description of the vehicle including, so far as the following data exists: its make, year-model, identifying number, type of body, whether new or used;
- 16 3. The date of purchase by applicant; and
- 4. Any further information reasonably required by the Secretary of State.
- 19 (b) The application for salvage certificate must also 20 contain the current odometer reading and that the stated 21 odometer reading is one of the following: actual mileage, not 22 the actual mileage or mileage is in excess of its mechanical
- 23 limits.

- 1 (b-5) Each application for a salvage certificate for a
 2 motor vehicle shall be verified by the National Motor Vehicle
 3 Title Information System (NMVTIS) for a vehicle history report
 4 prior to the Secretary issuing a salvage certificate.
 - (c) A salvage certificate may be assigned to any person licensed under this Act as a rebuilder, automotive parts recycler, or scrap processor, or to an out-of-state salvage vehicle buyer. A salvage certificate for a vehicle that has come from a police impoundment may be assigned to a municipal fire department. A junking certificate may be assigned to anyone. The provisions for reassignment by dealers under paragraph (a) of Section 3-113 shall apply to salvage certificates, except as provided in Section 3-117.2. A salvage certificate may be assigned reassigned to one other person to whom a salvage certificate may be assigned pursuant to this Section.
