### SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

815 ILCS 325/8

from Ch. 121 1/2, par. 328

Amends the Recyclable Metal Purchase Registration Law. Provides that any recyclable metal dealer or other person who knowingly fails to record the purchase of 30 or more catalytic converters is guilty of a Class 4 felony.

# 2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, 3 represented in the General Assembly:

Section 5. The Recyclable Metal Purchase Registration Law
is amended by changing Section 8 as follows:

6 (815 ILCS 325/8) (from Ch. 121 1/2, par. 328)

7 Sec. 8. Penalty. Any recyclable metal dealer or other person who knowingly fails to comply with this Act is quilty of 8 9 a Class A misdemeanor for the first offense, and a Class 4 felony for the second or subsequent offense, except that any 10 recyclable metal dealer or other person who knowingly fails to 11 record the purchase of 30 or more catalytic converters is 12 quilty of a Class 4 felony. Each day that any recyclable metal 13 14 dealer so fails to comply shall constitute a separate offense. Any metal obtained not in accordance with this Act is subject 15 16 to immediate forfeiture.
