SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

105 ILCS 5/24-3.1 new

Amends the Employment of Teachers Article of the School Code. Provides that for any teacher who is elected by the association's membership to represent the association for federal advocacy work, for up to 10 days in any school year spent by a teacher during the term, time spent in attendance at a meeting or gathering for federal advocacy work shall be considered time expended in the service of the district and no deduction of wages shall be made for such attendance.

4 Section 5. The School Code is amended by adding Section
5 24-3.1 as follows:

7 Sec. 24-3.1. Attendance for federal advocacy work. For any
8 teacher who is a member of a statewide association
9 representing teachers, who is elected by the association's
10 membership to represent the association for federal advocacy
11 work, for up to 10 days in any school year spent by a teacher
12 during the term, time spent in attendance at a meeting or
13 gathering for federal advocacy work shall be considered time
14 expended in the service of the district and no deduction of
15 wages shall be made for such attendance.
