13	Illinois on behalf of organizations that have been authorized
14	by the General Assembly to issue decals for Universal special
15	license plates. Appropriate documentation, as determined by
16	the Secretary, shall accompany each application. Authorized

1 organizations shall be designated by amendment to this Section. When applying for a Universal special license plate 2 3 the applicant shall inform the Secretary of the name of the 4 authorized organization from which the applicant will obtain a 5 decal to place on the plate. The Secretary shall make a record 6 of that organization and that organization shall remain affiliated with that plate until the plate is surrendered, 7 revoked, or otherwise cancelled. The authorized organization 8 9 may charge a fee to offset the cost of producing and 10 distributing the decal, but that fee shall be retained by the 11 authorized organization and shall be separate and distinct from any registration fees charged by the Secretary. No decal, 12 13 sticker, or other material may be affixed to a Universal special license plate other than a decal authorized by the 14 15 General Assembly in this Section or a registration renewal 16 sticker. The special plates issued under this Section shall be affixed only to passenger vehicles of the first division, 17 including motorcycles and autocycles, or motor vehicles of the 18 second division weighing not more than 8,000 pounds. Plates 19 20 issued under this Section shall expire according to the 21 multi-year procedure under Section 3-414.1 of this Code.

(b) The design, color, and format of the Universal special
license plate shall be wholly within the discretion of the
Secretary. Universal special license plates are not required
to designate "Land of Lincoln", as prescribed in subsection
(b) of Section 3-412 of this Code. The design shall allow for

1 the application of a decal to the plate. Organizations authorized by the General Assembly to issue decals for 2 Universal special license plates shall comply with rules 3 4 adopted by the Secretary governing the requirements for and 5 approval of Universal special license plate decals. The 6 Secretary may, in his or her discretion, allow Universal special license plates to be issued as vanity or personalized 7 plates in accordance with Section 3-405.1 of this Code. The 8 9 Secretary of State must make a version of the special 10 registration plates authorized under this Section in a form 11 appropriate for motorcycles and autocycles.

(c) When authorizing a Universal special license plate, 12 13 the General Assembly shall set forth whether an additional fee is to be charged for the plate and, if a fee is to be charged, 14 15 the amount of the fee and how the fee is to be distributed. 16 When necessary, the authorizing language shall create a special fund in the State treasury into which fees may be 17 deposited for an authorized Universal special license plate. 18 19 Additional fees may only be charged if the fee is to be paid 20 over to a State agency or to a charitable entity that is in 21 compliance with the registration and reporting requirements of 22 the Charitable Trust Act and the Solicitation for Charity Act. 23 Any charitable entity receiving fees for the sale of Universal 24 special license plates shall annually provide the Secretary of 25 State a letter of compliance issued by the Attorney General 26 verifying that the entity is in compliance with the Charitable

Trust Act and the Solicitation for Charity Act.

Upon original issuance and for each registration 2 (d) 3 renewal period, in addition to the appropriate registration 4 fee, if applicable, the Secretary shall collect any additional 5 fees, if required, for issuance of Universal special license plates. The fees shall be collected on behalf of the 6 7 organization designated by the applicant when applying for the 8 plate. All fees collected shall be transferred to the State 9 agency on whose behalf the fees were collected, or paid into 10 the special fund designated in the law authorizing the 11 organization to issue decals for Universal special license plates. All money in the designated fund shall be distributed 12 13 by the Secretary subject to appropriation by the General 14 Assembly.

in the Horsemen's Council of Illinois Fund shall be paid as grants to the Horsemen's Council of Illinois.

3 (4) The Post-Traumatic Stress Disorder Awareness Fund.
4 All money in the Post-Traumatic Stress Disorder Awareness
5 Fund shall be paid as grants to K9s for Veterans, NFP for
6 support, education, and awareness of veterans with
7 post-traumatic stress disorder.

8 (5) The Guide Dogs of America Fund. All money in the 9 Guide Dogs of America Fund shall be paid as grants to the 10 International Guiding Eyes, Inc., doing business as Guide 11 Dogs of America.

12 (6) The Mechanics Training Fund. All money in the
13 Mechanics Training Fund shall be paid as grants to the
14 Mechanics Local 701 Training Fund.

(7) The Theresa Tracy Trot - Illinois CancerCare
Foundation Fund. All money in the Theresa Tracy Trot Illinois CancerCare Foundation Fund shall be paid to the
Illinois CancerCare Foundation for the purpose of
furthering pancreatic cancer research.

(8) The Developmental Disabilities Awareness Fund. All money in the Developmental Disabilities Awareness Fund shall be paid as grants to the Illinois Department of Human Services to fund legal aid groups to assist with guardianship fees for private citizens willing to become guardians for individuals with developmental disabilities but who are unable to pay the legal fees associated with

(9) The Pediatric Cancer Awareness Fund. All money in
the Pediatric Cancer Awareness Fund shall be paid as
grants to the Cancer Center at Illinois for pediatric
cancer treatment and research.

6 (10) The Folds of Honor Foundation Fund. All money in 7 the Folds of Honor Foundation Fund shall be paid as grants 8 to the Folds of Honor Foundation to aid in providing 9 educational scholarships to military families.

10 (11) The Experimental Aircraft Association Fund. All 11 money in the Experimental Aircraft Association Fund shall 12 be paid, subject to appropriation by the General Assembly 13 and distribution by the Secretary, as grants to promote 14 recreational aviation.

15 (12) The Child Abuse Council of the Quad Cities Fund.
16 All money in the Child Abuse Council of the Quad Cities
17 Fund shall be paid as grants to benefit the Child Abuse
18 Council of the Quad Cities.

(13) The Illinois Health Care Workers Benefit Fund.
All money in the Illinois Health Care Workers Benefit Fund
shall be paid as grants to the Trinity Health Foundation
for the benefit of health care workers, doctors, nurses,
and others who work in the health care industry in this
State.

(14) The Future Farmers of America Fund. All money in
 the Future Farmers of America Fund shall be paid as grants
