1 AMENDMENT TO HOUSE BILL 3436

2 AMENDMENT NO. _____. Amend House Bill 3436, AS AMENDED,
3 by replacing everything after the enacting clause with the
4 following:

5 "Section 5. The Illinois Vehicle Code is amended by
6 changing Section 3-699.14 as follows:

7 (625 ILCS 5/3-699.14)

8 Sec. 3-699.14. Universal special license plates.

9 (a) In addition to any other special license plate, the
10 Secretary, upon receipt of all applicable fees and
11 applications made in the form prescribed by the Secretary, may
12 issue Universal special license plates to residents of
13 Illinois on behalf of organizations that have been authorized
14 by the General Assembly to issue decals for Universal special
15 license plates. Appropriate documentation, as determined by
16 the Secretary, shall accompany each application. Authorized

1 organizations shall be designated by amendment to this
2 Section. When applying for a Universal special license plate
3 the applicant shall inform the Secretary of the name of the
4 authorized organization from which the applicant will obtain a
5 decal to place on the plate. The Secretary shall make a record
6 of that organization and that organization shall remain
7 affiliated with that plate until the plate is surrendered,
8 revoked, or otherwise cancelled. The authorized organization
9 may charge a fee to offset the cost of producing and
10 distributing the decal, but that fee shall be retained by the
11 authorized organization and shall be separate and distinct
12 from any registration fees charged by the Secretary. No decal,
13 sticker, or other material may be affixed to a Universal
14 special license plate other than a decal authorized by the
15 General Assembly in this Section or a registration renewal
16 sticker. The special plates issued under this Section shall be
17 affixed only to passenger vehicles of the first division,
18 including motorcycles and autocycles, or motor vehicles of the
19 second division weighing not more than 8,000 pounds. Plates
20 issued under this Section shall expire according to the
21 multi-year procedure under Section 3-414.1 of this Code.

22 (b) The design, color, and format of the Universal special
23 license plate shall be wholly within the discretion of the
24 Secretary. Universal special license plates are not required
25 to designate "Land of Lincoln", as prescribed in subsection
26 (b) of Section 3-412 of this Code. The design shall allow for

1 the application of a decal to the plate. Organizations
2 authorized by the General Assembly to issue decals for
3 Universal special license plates shall comply with rules
4 adopted by the Secretary governing the requirements for and
5 approval of Universal special license plate decals. The
6 Secretary may, in his or her discretion, allow Universal
7 special license plates to be issued as vanity or personalized
8 plates in accordance with Section 3-405.1 of this Code. The
9 Secretary of State must make a version of the special
10 registration plates authorized under this Section in a form
11 appropriate for motorcycles and autocycles.

12 (c) When authorizing a Universal special license plate,
13 the General Assembly shall set forth whether an additional fee
14 is to be charged for the plate and, if a fee is to be charged,
15 the amount of the fee and how the fee is to be distributed.
16 When necessary, the authorizing language shall create a
17 special fund in the State treasury into which fees may be
18 deposited for an authorized Universal special license plate.
19 Additional fees may only be charged if the fee is to be paid
20 over to a State agency or to a charitable entity that is in
21 compliance with the registration and reporting requirements of
22 the Charitable Trust Act and the Solicitation for Charity Act.
23 Any charitable entity receiving fees for the sale of Universal
24 special license plates shall annually provide the Secretary of
25 State a letter of compliance issued by the Attorney General
26 verifying that the entity is in compliance with the Charitable

1 Trust Act and the Solicitation for Charity Act.

2 (d) Upon original issuance and for each registration
3 renewal period, in addition to the appropriate registration
4 fee, if applicable, the Secretary shall collect any additional
5 fees, if required, for issuance of Universal special license
6 plates. The fees shall be collected on behalf of the
7 organization designated by the applicant when applying for the
8 plate. All fees collected shall be transferred to the State
9 agency on whose behalf the fees were collected, or paid into
10 the special fund designated in the law authorizing the
11 organization to issue decals for Universal special license
12 plates. All money in the designated fund shall be distributed
13 by the Secretary subject to appropriation by the General
14 Assembly.

15 (e) The following organizations may issue decals for
16 Universal special license plates with the original and renewal
17 fees and fee distribution as follows:

18 (1) The Illinois Department of Natural Resources.

19 (A) Original issuance: \$25; with \$10 to the
20 Roadside Monarch Habitat Fund and \$15 to the Secretary
21 of State Special License Plate Fund.

22 (B) Renewal: \$25; with \$23 to the Roadside Monarch
23 Habitat Fund and \$2 to the Secretary of State Special
24 License Plate Fund.

25 (2) Illinois Veterans' Homes.

26 (A) Original issuance: \$26, which shall be

1 deposited into the Illinois Veterans' Homes Fund.

2 (B) Renewal: \$26, which shall be deposited into
3 the Illinois Veterans' Homes Fund.

4 (3) The Illinois Department of Human Services for
5 volunteerism decals.

6 (A) Original issuance: \$25, which shall be
7 deposited into the Secretary of State Special License
8 Plate Fund.

9 (B) Renewal: \$25, which shall be deposited into
10 the Secretary of State Special License Plate Fund.

11 (4) The Illinois Department of Public Health.

12 (A) Original issuance: \$25; with \$10 to the
13 Prostate Cancer Awareness Fund and \$15 to the
14 Secretary of State Special License Plate Fund.

15 (B) Renewal: \$25; with \$23 to the Prostate Cancer
16 Awareness Fund and \$2 to the Secretary of State
17 Special License Plate Fund.

18 (5) Horsemen's Council of Illinois.

19 (A) Original issuance: \$25; with \$10 to the
20 Horsemen's Council of Illinois Fund and \$15 to the
21 Secretary of State Special License Plate Fund.

22 (B) Renewal: \$25; with \$23 to the Horsemen's
23 Council of Illinois Fund and \$2 to the Secretary of
24 State Special License Plate Fund.

25 (6) K9s for Veterans, NFP.

26 (A) Original issuance: \$25; with \$10 to the

1 Post-Traumatic Stress Disorder Awareness Fund and \$15
2 to the Secretary of State Special License Plate Fund.

3 (B) Renewal: \$25; with \$23 to the Post-Traumatic
4 Stress Disorder Awareness Fund and \$2 to the Secretary
5 of State Special License Plate Fund.

6 (7) The International Association of Machinists and
7 Aerospace Workers.

8 (A) Original issuance: \$35; with \$20 to the Guide
9 Dogs of America Fund and \$15 to the Secretary of State
10 Special License Plate Fund.

11 (B) Renewal: \$25; with \$23 going to the Guide Dogs
12 of America Fund and \$2 to the Secretary of State
13 Special License Plate Fund.

14 (8) Local Lodge 701 of the International Association
15 of Machinists and Aerospace Workers.

16 (A) Original issuance: \$35; with \$10 to the Guide
17 Dogs of America Fund, \$10 to the Mechanics Training
18 Fund, and \$15 to the Secretary of State Special
19 License Plate Fund.

20 (B) Renewal: \$30; with \$13 to the Guide Dogs of
21 America Fund, \$15 to the Mechanics Training Fund, and
22 \$2 to the Secretary of State Special License Plate
23 Fund.

24 (9) Illinois Department of Human Services.

25 (A) Original issuance: \$25; with \$10 to the
26 Theresa Tracy Trot - Illinois CancerCare Foundation

1 Fund and \$15 to the Secretary of State Special License
2 Plate Fund.

3 (B) Renewal: \$25; with \$23 to the Theresa Tracy
4 Trot - Illinois CancerCare Foundation Fund and \$2 to
5 the Secretary of State Special License Plate Fund.

6 (10) The Illinois Department of Human Services for
7 developmental disabilities awareness decals.

8 (A) Original issuance: \$25; with \$10 to the
9 Developmental Disabilities Awareness Fund and \$15 to
10 the Secretary of State Special License Plate Fund.

11 (B) Renewal: \$25; with \$23 to the Developmental
12 Disabilities Awareness Fund and \$2 to the Secretary of
13 State Special License Plate Fund.

14 (11) The Illinois Department of Human Services for
15 pediatric cancer awareness decals.

16 (A) Original issuance: \$25; with \$10 to the
17 Pediatric Cancer Awareness Fund and \$15 to the
18 Secretary of State Special License Plate Fund.

19 (B) Renewal: \$25; with \$23 to the Pediatric Cancer
20 Awareness Fund and \$2 to the Secretary of State
21 Special License Plate Fund.

22 (12) The Department of Veterans' Affairs for Fold of
23 Honor decals.

24 (A) Original issuance: \$25; with \$10 to the Folds
25 of Honor Foundation Fund and \$15 to the Secretary of
26 State Special License Plate Fund.

1 (B) Renewal: \$25; with \$23 to the Folds of Honor
2 Foundation Fund and \$2 to the Secretary of State
3 Special License Plate Fund.

4 (13) The Illinois chapters of the Experimental
5 Aircraft Association for aviation enthusiast decals.

6 (A) Original issuance: \$25; with \$10 to the
7 Experimental Aircraft Association Fund and \$15 to the
8 Secretary of State Special License Plate Fund.

9 (B) Renewal: \$25; with \$23 to the Experimental
10 Aircraft Association Fund and \$2 to the Secretary of
11 State Special License Plate Fund.

12 (14) The Illinois Department of Human Services for
13 Child Abuse Council of the Quad Cities decals.

14 (A) Original issuance: \$25; with \$10 to the Child
15 Abuse Council of the Quad Cities Fund and \$15 to the
16 Secretary of State Special License Plate Fund.

17 (B) Renewal: \$25; with \$23 to the Child Abuse
18 Council of the Quad Cities Fund and \$2 to the Secretary
19 of State Special License Plate Fund.

20 (15) The Illinois Department of Public Health for
21 health care worker decals.

22 (A) Original issuance: \$25; with \$10 to the
23 Illinois Health Care Workers Benefit Fund, and \$15 to
24 the Secretary of State Special License Plate Fund.

25 (B) Renewal: \$25; with \$23 to the Illinois Health
26 Care Workers Benefit Fund and \$2 to the Secretary of

1 State Special License Plate Fund.

2 (16) The Department of Agriculture for Future Farmers
3 of America decals.

4 (A) Original issuance: \$25; with \$10 to the Future
5 Farmers of America Fund and \$15 to the Secretary of
6 State Special License Plate Fund.

7 (B) Renewal: \$25; with \$23 to the Future Farmers
8 of America Fund and \$2 to the Secretary of State
9 Special License Plate Fund.

10 (17) The IBEW Thank a Line Worker decal.

11 (A) Original issuance: \$15, which shall be
12 deposited into the Secretary of State Special License
13 Plate Fund.

14 (B) Renewal: \$2, which shall be deposited into the
15 Secretary of State Special License Plate Fund.

16 (f) The following funds are created as special funds in
17 the State treasury:

18 (1) The Roadside Monarch Habitat Fund. All money in
19 the Roadside Monarch Habitat Fund shall be paid as grants
20 to the Illinois Department of Natural Resources to fund
21 roadside monarch and other pollinator habitat development,
22 enhancement, and restoration projects in this State.

23 (2) The Prostate Cancer Awareness Fund. All money in
24 the Prostate Cancer Awareness Fund shall be paid as grants
25 to the Prostate Cancer Foundation of Chicago.

26 (3) The Horsemen's Council of Illinois Fund. All money

1 in the Horsemen's Council of Illinois Fund shall be paid
2 as grants to the Horsemen's Council of Illinois.

3 (4) The Post-Traumatic Stress Disorder Awareness Fund.
4 All money in the Post-Traumatic Stress Disorder Awareness
5 Fund shall be paid as grants to K9s for Veterans, NFP for
6 support, education, and awareness of veterans with
7 post-traumatic stress disorder.

8 (5) The Guide Dogs of America Fund. All money in the
9 Guide Dogs of America Fund shall be paid as grants to the
10 International Guiding Eyes, Inc., doing business as Guide
11 Dogs of America.

12 (6) The Mechanics Training Fund. All money in the
13 Mechanics Training Fund shall be paid as grants to the
14 Mechanics Local 701 Training Fund.

15 (7) The Theresa Tracy Trot - Illinois CancerCare
16 Foundation Fund. All money in the Theresa Tracy Trot -
17 Illinois CancerCare Foundation Fund shall be paid to the
18 Illinois CancerCare Foundation for the purpose of
19 furthering pancreatic cancer research.

20 (8) The Developmental Disabilities Awareness Fund. All
21 money in the Developmental Disabilities Awareness Fund
22 shall be paid as grants to the Illinois Department of
23 Human Services to fund legal aid groups to assist with
24 guardianship fees for private citizens willing to become
25 guardians for individuals with developmental disabilities
26 but who are unable to pay the legal fees associated with

1 becoming a guardian.

2 (9) The Pediatric Cancer Awareness Fund. All money in
3 the Pediatric Cancer Awareness Fund shall be paid as
4 grants to the Cancer Center at Illinois for pediatric
5 cancer treatment and research.

6 (10) The Folds of Honor Foundation Fund. All money in
7 the Folds of Honor Foundation Fund shall be paid as grants
8 to the Folds of Honor Foundation to aid in providing
9 educational scholarships to military families.

10 (11) The Experimental Aircraft Association Fund. All
11 money in the Experimental Aircraft Association Fund shall
12 be paid, subject to appropriation by the General Assembly
13 and distribution by the Secretary, as grants to promote
14 recreational aviation.

15 (12) The Child Abuse Council of the Quad Cities Fund.
16 All money in the Child Abuse Council of the Quad Cities
17 Fund shall be paid as grants to benefit the Child Abuse
18 Council of the Quad Cities.

19 (13) The Illinois Health Care Workers Benefit Fund.
20 All money in the Illinois Health Care Workers Benefit Fund
21 shall be paid as grants to the Trinity Health Foundation
22 for the benefit of health care workers, doctors, nurses,
23 and others who work in the health care industry in this
24 State.

25 (14) The Future Farmers of America Fund. All money in
26 the Future Farmers of America Fund shall be paid as grants

1 to the Illinois Association of Future Farmers of America.
