SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

625 ILCS 5/3-412

from Ch. 95 1/2, par. 3-412

Amends the Illinois Vehicle Code. Provides that registration plates or digital registration plates issued to a vehicle registered as a fleet vehicle may display the logo of the company for which the fleet is being operated at the company's request. Provides that the Secretary of State may charge the company a customization fee in an amount no greater than the cost to customize the fleet plate.

AN ACT concerning transportation.

2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, 3 represented in the General Assembly:

4 Section 5. The Illinois Vehicle Code is amended by 5 changing Section 3-412 as follows:

6 (625 ILCS 5/3-412) (from Ch. 95 1/2, par. 3-412)

Sec. 3-412. Registration plates or digital registration
plates and registration stickers or digital registration
stickers to be furnished by the Secretary of State.

(a) The Secretary of State upon registering a vehicle 10 subject to annual registration for the first time shall issue 11 or shall cause to be issued to the owner one registration plate 12 or digital registration plate for a motorcycle, trailer, 13 14 semitrailer, moped, autocycle, truck-tractor, 2 or registration plates, or a digital registration plate and metal 15 16 plate as set forth in Section 3-401.5, for other motor 17 vehicles and, where applicable, current registration stickers or digital registration stickers for motor vehicles of the 18 19 first division. The provisions of this Section may be made applicable to such vehicles of the second division, as the 20 21 Secretary of State may, from time to time, in his discretion 22 designate. On subsequent annual registrations during the term of the registration plate or digital registration plate as 23

provided in Section 3-414.1, the Secretary shall issue or 1 2 issued registration stickers cause to be or digital registration stickers as evidence of current registration. 3 However, the issuance of annual registration stickers or 4 5 digital registration stickers to vehicles registered under the provisions of Sections 3-402.1 and 3-405.3 of this Code may 6 7 be required if the Secretary deems the issuance not 8 unnecessary.

9 (b) Every registration plate or digital registration plate 10 shall have displayed upon it the registration number assigned 11 to the vehicle for which it is issued, the name of this State, 12 which may be abbreviated, the year number for which it was issued, which may be abbreviated, the phrase "Land of Lincoln" 13 (except as otherwise provided in this Code), and such other 14 15 letters or numbers as the Secretary may prescribe. However, 16 for apportionment plates issued to vehicles registered under 17 Section 3-402.1 and fleet plates issued to vehicles registered under Section 3-405.3, the phrase "Land of Lincoln" may be 18 omitted to allow for the word "apportioned", the word "fleet", 19 20 or other similar language to be displayed. Registration plates or digital registration plates issued to a vehicle registered 21 22 as a fleet vehicle may display a designation determined by the 23 Secretary. Registration plates or digital registration plates 24 issued to a vehicle registered as a fleet vehicle may also 25 display the logo of the company for which the fleet is being operated at the company's request. The Secretary may charge 26

1 <u>the company a customization fee in an amount no greater than</u> 2 the cost to customize the fleet plate.

3 The Secretary may in his discretion prescribe that letters be used as prefixes only on registration plates or digital 4 5 registration plates issued to vehicles of the first division which are registered under this Code and only as suffixes on 6 7 registration plates or digital registration plates issued to 8 other vehicles. Every registration sticker or digital 9 registration sticker issued as evidence of current 10 registration shall designate the year number for which it is issued and such other letters or numbers as the Secretary may 11 12 prescribe and shall be of a contrasting color with the 13 digital registration plates registration plates or and registration stickers or digital registration stickers of the 14 15 previous year.

16 (c) Each registration plate or digital registration plate 17 and the required letters and numerals thereon, except the year 18 number for which issued, shall be of sufficient size to be 19 plainly readable from a distance of 100 feet during daylight, 20 and shall be coated with reflectorizing material. The 21 dimensions of the plate issued to vehicles of the first 22 division shall be 6 by 12 inches.

(d) The Secretary of State shall issue for every passenger motor vehicle rented without a driver the same type of registration plates or digital registration plates as the type of plates issued for a private passenger vehicle.

(e) The Secretary of State shall issue for every passenger
 car used as a taxicab or livery, distinctive registration
 plates or digital registration plates.

4 (f) The Secretary of State shall issue for every 5 motorcycle distinctive registration plates or digital 6 registration plates distinguishing between motorcycles having 7 150 or more cubic centimeters piston displacement, or having 8 less than 150 cubic centimeter piston displacement.

9 (g) Registration plates or digital registration plates 10 issued to vehicles for-hire may display a designation as 11 determined by the Secretary that such vehicles are for-hire.

(h) (Blank).

13 (i) The Secretary of State shall issue for every public digital 14 and private ambulance registration plates or 15 registration plates identifying the vehicle as an ambulance. 16 The Secretary shall forward to the Department of Healthcare 17 and Family Services registration information for the purpose of verification of claims filed with the Department by 18 19 ambulance owners for payment for services to public assistance 20 recipients.

(j) The Secretary of State shall issue for every public and private medical carrier or rescue vehicle livery registration plates or digital registration plates displaying numbers within ranges of numbers reserved respectively for medical carriers and rescue vehicles. The Secretary shall forward to the Department of Healthcare and Family Services

registration information for the purpose of verification of claims filed with the Department by owners of medical carriers or rescue vehicles for payment for services to public assistance recipients.

5 (k) The Secretary of State shall issue distinctive license 6 plates or digital registration plates or distinctive license 7 plate stickers or digital registration stickers for every 8 vehicle exempted from subsections (a) and (a-5) of Section 9 12-503 by subsection (q) of that Section, and by subsection 10 (q-5) of that Section before its deletion by this amendatory 11 Act of the 95th General Assembly. The Secretary shall issue 12 these plates or stickers immediately upon receiving the physician's certification required under subsection (g) of 13 Section 12-503. New plates or stickers shall also be issued 14 15 when the certification is renewed as provided in that 16 subsection.

17 (1) The Secretary of State shall issue distinctive 18 registration plates or digital registration plates for 19 low-speed vehicles.

20 (m) The Secretary of State shall issue distinctive 21 registration plates or digital registration plates for 22 autocycles. The dimensions of the plate issued to autocycles 23 shall be 4 by 7 inches.
