SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

815 ILCS 505/2BBBB new

Amends the Consumer Fraud and Deceptive Business Practices Act. Provides that no person shall sell, attempt to sell, or offer to sell to a consumer in this State a gas stove that is manufactured on or after January 1, 2024 unless a label on the gas stove bears a specified warning message. Provides that a person who violates the new provisions commits an unlawful practice within the meaning of the Act. Defines "gas stove".

1 AN ACT concerning business.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. The Consumer Fraud and Deceptive Business

 Practices Act is amended by adding Section 2BBBB as follows:
- 6 (815 ILCS 505/2BBBB new)
- 7 <u>Sec. 2BBBB. Gas stoves.</u>
- 8 (a) As used in this Section, "gas stove" means a household
- 9 <u>natural gas stove or range that is used for food preparation</u>
- and provides at least one of the following functions:
- 11 (1) surface cooking;
- 12 (2) oven cooking; or
- 13 (3) broiling.
- 14 (b) No person shall sell, attempt to sell, or offer to sell
- to a consumer in this State a gas stove that is manufactured on
- or after January 1, 2024 unless a label on the gas stove bears
- 17 the message:
- 18 WARNING: Gas stoves can release nitrogen dioxide and
- carbon monoxide inside homes at levels exceeding the EPA's
- 20 <u>standards for outdoor air quality. The presence of these</u>
- 21 <u>pollutants may exacerbate pre existing respiratory</u>
- 22 <u>illnesses or lead to the development of asthma, especially</u>
- in children. Gas powered stoves should never be used

1	without a ducted vent hood to reduce exposure to these

4	The label shall be attached to the gas stove in a
5	conspicuous location. The label must be in a type size no
6	smaller than the largest type size used for other consumer
7	information on the product. The Attorney General may adopt
8	rules regarding the placement and format of the label.
