

## 103RD GENERAL ASSEMBLY State of Illinois 2023 and 2024 HB3639

## SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

215 ILCS 5/356z.33

Amends the Accident and Health Article of the Illinois Insurance Code. Provides that an insurer that provides coverage for medically necessary epinephrine injectors shall limit the total amount that an insured is required to pay for a twin-pack of medically necessary epinephrine injectors at an amount not to exceed \$60, regardless of the type of epinephrine injector. Provides that nothing in the provisions prevents an insurer from reducing an insured's cost sharing by an amount greater than the specified amount. Provides that the Department of Insurance may adopt rules as necessary to implement and administer the provisions.

## Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. The Illinois Insurance Code is amended by changing Section 356z.33 as follows:
- 6 (215 ILCS 5/356z.33)

the Epinephrine Injector Act.

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- 7 Sec. 356z.33. Coverage for epinephrine injectors.
- (a) A group or individual policy of accident and health insurance or a managed care plan that is amended, delivered, issued, or renewed on or after January 1, 2020 (the effective date of Public Act 101-281) shall provide coverage for medically necessary epinephrine injectors for persons 18 years of age or under. As used in this Section, "epinephrine injector" has the meaning given to that term in Section 5 of
  - (b) An insurer that provides coverage for medically necessary epinephrine injectors shall limit the total amount that an insured is required to pay for a twin-pack of medically necessary epinephrine injectors at an amount not to exceed \$60, regardless of the type of epinephrine injector.
- 21 (c) Nothing in this Section prevents an insurer from 22 reducing an insured's cost sharing by an amount greater than 23 the amount specified in subsection (b).
