### SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

405 ILCS 80/7-5 new

Amends the Developmental Disability and Mental Disability Services Act. Requires the Department of Human Services to establish family centers throughout the State to provide counseling and mental health services to families who are indigent based on any behavior or mental health condition as determined by Department rule. Provides that the Department shall employ or contract with psychiatrists, clinical psychologists, clinical social workers, and licensed marriage and family therapists to provide those services.

4 Section 5. The Developmental Disability and Mental  
5 Disability Services Act is by adding Section 7-5 as follows:

7 Sec. 7-5. Mental health services for indigent families.  
8 The Department of Human Services shall establish family  
9 centers throughout this State to provide counseling and mental  
10 health services to families who are indigent based on any  
11 behavior or mental health condition as determined by  
12 Department rule. The Department shall employ or contract with  
13 psychiatrists, clinical psychologists, clinical social  
14 workers, and licensed marriage and family therapists to
