

1 AN ACT concerning State government.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,**  
3 **represented in the General Assembly:**

4 Section 5. The Department of Employment Security Law of  
5 the Civil Administrative Code of Illinois is amended by  
6 changing Section 1005-130 as follows:

8 Sec. 1005-130. Exchange of information for child support  
9 enforcement.

10 (a) The Department has the power to exchange with the  
11 Department of Healthcare and Family Services information that  
12 may be necessary for the enforcement of child support orders  
13 entered pursuant to the Illinois Public Aid Code, the Illinois  
14 Marriage and Dissolution of Marriage Act, the Non-Support of  
15 Spouse and Children Act, the Non-Support Punishment Act, the  
16 Revised Uniform Reciprocal Enforcement of Support Act, the  
17 Uniform Interstate Family Support Act, the Illinois Parentage  
18 Act of 1984, or the Illinois Parentage Act of 2015.

19 (b) Notwithstanding any provisions in the Civil  
20 Administrative Code of Illinois to the contrary, the  
21 Department of Employment Security shall not be liable to any  
22 person for any disclosure of information to the Department of  
23 Healthcare and Family Services (formerly Illinois Department

1 of Public Aid) under subsection (a) or for any other action  
2 taken in good faith to comply with the requirements of  
3 subsection (a).

4 (c) The Department, in collaboration with the Department  
5 of Healthcare and Family Services and the Department of  
6 Central Management Services, shall implement a pilot program  
7 that seeks to connect parents in arrearage on child support  
8 obligations with work opportunities. The work opportunities  
9 provided to program participants shall include opportunities  
10 offered by employers located in the State of Illinois  
11 including, but not limited to, State employment. The pilot  
12 program shall end on June 30, 2025. No later than 60 days after  
13 the end of the pilot program, the Department shall provide a  
14 program report to the General Assembly. This subsection is  
15 repealed on January 1, 2026.
