1 AMENDMENT TO HOUSE BILL 3907

2 AMENDMENT NO. \_\_\_\_\_. Amend House Bill 3907 by replacing  
3 everything after the enacting clause with the following:

4 "Section 5. The School Code is amended by adding Section  
5 24-9.5 as follows:

6 (105 ILCS 5/24-9.5 new)

7 Sec. 24-9.5. Teacher or clinician planning time.

8 (a) In this Section:

9 "Clinician" means a related service provider, including,  
10 but not limited to, a school social worker, school  
11 psychologist, school counselor, school nurse, school  
12 speech-language pathologist, or school physical or  
13 occupational therapist.

14 "Duty-free" means the time during which a teacher or  
15 clinician is not required to supervise students, collaborate  
16 with other school district employees, or attend meetings,

1 trainings, or conferences of any kind.

2 (b) For every teacher or clinician of a school district  
3 who is in contact with students at least 50% of the teacher's  
4 or clinician's contracted work day, on and after the effective  
5 date of this amendatory Act of the 103rd General Assembly, a  
6 school district may not reduce any designated, duty-free  
7 planning time that is provided to teachers or clinicians by  
8 the school district, as agreed upon by the exclusive  
9 bargaining representative of the teachers or clinicians and  
10 the school district. Any agreements made on or after the  
11 effective date of this amendatory Act of the 103rd General  
12 Assembly between the exclusive bargaining representative of  
13 the teachers or clinicians and the school district may not  
14 reduce designated, duty-free planning time.

15 (c) If a teacher or clinician chooses to relinquish the  
16 teacher's or clinician's entitlement to designated, duty-free  
17 planning time under subsection (b), then the teacher or  
18 clinician shall be compensated for that relinquishment at a  
19 collectively bargained rate of pay."
