### SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

Appropriates specified amounts to the Office of the State Appellate Defender for the following purposes: personal services; State contributions to Social Security; contractual services; travel; commodities; printing; equipment; EDP; telecommunications; ordinary and contingent expenses of the Expungement Program; to provide statewide training public defenders under the Public Defender Training Program; and to develop a Juvenile Defender Resource Center. Effective July 1, 2023.

A BILL FOR

1 AN ACT concerning appropriations.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented**  
3 **in the General Assembly:**

4 Section 5. The following named amounts, or so much of those  
5 amounts as may be necessary, respectively, for the objects and  
6 purposes named, are appropriated from the General Revenue Fund  
7 to meet the ordinary and contingent expenses of the Office of  
8 the State Appellate Defender.

9	For Personal Services .....	\$23,226,300
10	For State Contributions to Social Security .....	\$1,776,900
11	For Contractual Services .....	\$52,964,000
12	For Travel .....	\$47,000
13	For Commodities .....	\$33,000
14	For Printing .....	\$25,000
15	For Equipment .....	\$130,000
16	For EDP .....	\$1,634,700
17	For Telecommunications .....	<u>\$38,000</u>
18	Total	\$79,874,900

19 Section 10. The amount of \$210,800, or so much of that sum  
20 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue  
21 Fund to the Office of the State Appellate Defender for the

1 ordinary and contingent expenses of the Expungement Program.

2 Section 15. The amount of \$111,000, or so much of that sum  
3 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue  
4 Fund to the Office of the State Appellate Defender to provide  
5 statewide training to Public Defenders under the Public  
6 Defender Training Program.

7 Section 20. The amount of \$514,700, or so much of that sum  
8 as may be necessary, is appropriated from General Revenue Fund  
9 to the Office of the State Appellate Defender to develop a  
10 Juvenile Defender Resource Center.

11 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect July 1,  
12 2023.
