SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

Makes specified appropriations to the Legislative Information System, Legislative Printing Unit, Legislative Audit Commission, Legislative Reference Bureau, Joint Committee on Administrative Rules, Architect of the Capitol, Commission on Government Forecasting and Accountability, Legislative Ethics Commission, and Legislative Inspector General for their ordinary and contingent expenses in the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2023. Effective July 1, 2023.

A BILL FOR

1 AN ACT making appropriations.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented**
3 **in the General Assembly:**

4 Section 5. The sum of \$4,514,600, or so much thereof as may
5 be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue Fund to
6 the Commission on Government Forecasting and Accountability to
7 meet its operational expenses for the fiscal year beginning
8 July 1, 2023.

9 Section 10. The sum of \$1,500,000, or so much thereof as
10 may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue Fund
11 to the Commission on Government Forecasting and Accountability
12 for the purpose of making pension pick up contributions to the
13 State Employees' Retirement System of Illinois for affected
14 legislative staff employees for the fiscal year beginning July
15 1, 2023.

16 Section 15. The sum of \$1,969,500, or so much thereof as
17 may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue Fund
18 to the Architect of the Capitol to meet its operational expenses
19 for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2023.

20 Section 20. The sum of \$1,140,700, or so much thereof as

1 may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue Fund
2 to the Joint Committee on Administrative Rules to meet its
3 operational expenses for the fiscal year beginning July 1,
4 2023.

5 Section 25. The sum of \$475,000, or so much thereof as may
6 be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue Fund to
7 the Legislative Audit Commission to meet its operational
8 expenses for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2023.

9 Section 30. The sum of \$200,000, or so much thereof as may
10 be necessary, is appropriated to the Legislative Ethics
11 Commission to meet the ordinary and contingent expenses of the
12 Commission for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2023.

13 Section 35. The sum of \$920,000, or so much thereof as may
14 be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue Fund to
15 the Office of the Legislative Inspector General for its
16 ordinary and contingent expenses for the fiscal year beginning
17 July 1, 2023.

18 Section 40. The sum of \$6,166,700, or so much thereof as
19 may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue Fund
20 to the Legislative Information System to meet its operational
21 expenses for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2023.

1 Section 45. The following sum, or so much of that amount
 2 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue
 3 Assembly Computer Equipment Revolving Fund to the Legislative
 4 Information System for the fiscal year beginning, July 1, 2023:

5 For Purchase, Maintenance, and Rental of
 6 General Assembly Electronic Data Processing
 7 Equipment and for other operational purposes
 8 of the General Assembly1,600,000

9 Section 50. The sum of \$2,705,300, or so much thereof as
 10 may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue Fund
 11 to the Legislative Printing Unit to meet its operational
 12 expenses for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2023.

13 Section 55. The sum of \$3,815,000, or so much thereof as
 14 may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue Fund
 15 to the Legislative Reference Bureau to meet its operational
 16 expenses for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2023.

17 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect July 1,
 18 2023.
