15	vitro fertilization, uterine	embryo lavage, embryo transfer,

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artificial insemination, gamete intrafallopian tube transfer, 1 zygote intrafallopian tube transfer, and low tubal ovum 2 transfer and procedures necessary to screen or diagnose a 3 4 fertilized egg before implantation, including, but not limited 5 to, preimplantation genetic diagnosis, preimplantation genetic screening, and prenatal genetic diagnosis. Coverage under this 6 subsection for the diagnosis and treatment of infertility 7 8 shall be required only if the procedures: 9 (1) are considered medically appropriate by the

10patient's medical provider based on clinical guidelines or11standards developed by the American Society for12Reproductive Medicine, the American College of13Obstetricians and Gynecologists, or the Society for14Assisted Reproductive Technology; and

15 <u>(2) are performed at medical facilities or clinics</u> 16 <u>that conform to the American College of Obstetricians and</u> 17 <u>Gynecologists quidelines for in vitro fertilization or the</u> 18 <u>American Society for Reproductive Medicine minimum</u> 19 <u>standards for practices offering assisted reproductive</u> 20 technologies."; and
