SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

Amends the Court Reporters Act. Provides that each court reporter may be required by the chief judge to (rather than shall) take a test to verify his or her proficiency within one year of employment.

1 AN ACT concerning courts.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. The Court Reporters Act is amended by changing

 Section 7 as follows:
- 6 (705 ILCS 70/7) (from Ch. 37, par. 657)
- 7 Sec. 7. Proficiency tests. Each court reporter may be required by the chief judge to shall take a test to verify his 8 9 or her proficiency within one year of employment. The test prepared and administered by the 10 11 representative in consultation with each of the other employer representatives pursuant to standards set by rules. A 12 proficiency test passed prior to employment may be accepted by 13 14 the chief judge as proof of proficiency.
