| 12 | gaining, or maintaining acceptance, membership, office, or |
| 13 | other status in induction or admission into any group, |
| 14 | organization, or society associated or connected with that |
| 15 | institution, regardless of the student or other person's |
| 16 | willingness to perform the act, if: |

| 1 | (1) the act is <u>neither</u> not sanctioned or authorized by |

| 2 | that educational institution <u>nor is a customary athletic</u> |

| 4 | (2) the act <u>either (i) subjects any person to a</u> |
| 5 | substantial risk of physical harm, mental harm, or |
| 6 | degradation or (ii) causes any person to suffer physical |
| 7 | harm, mental harm, or degradation results in bodily harm |
| 8 | to any person. |
| 9 | (b) Sentence. Hazing is a Class A misdemeanor, except that |
| 10 | hazing that results in death or great bodily harm is a Class 4 |
| 11 | felony. |
