1 AMENDMENT TO HOUSE BILL 4535

2 AMENDMENT NO. \_\_\_\_\_. Amend House Bill 4535 by replacing  
3 everything after the enacting clause with the following:

4 "Section 5. The Illinois Vehicle Code is amended by  
5 changing Sections 3-651, 3-698, and 3-699.15 as follows:

6 (625 ILCS 5/3-651)

7 Sec. 3-651. U.S. Marine Corps license plates.

8 (a) In addition to any other special license plate, the  
9 Secretary, upon receipt of all applicable fees and  
10 applications made in the form prescribed by the Secretary of  
11 State, may issue special registration plates designated as  
12 U.S. Marine Corps license plates to residents of Illinois who  
13 meet eligibility requirements prescribed by the Secretary of  
14 State. The special plate issued under this Section shall be  
15 affixed only to passenger vehicles of the first division,  
16 motorcycles, motor vehicles of the second division weighing

1 not more than 8,000 pounds, and recreational vehicles as  
2 defined by Section 1-169 of this Code. Plates issued under  
3 this Section shall expire according to the staggered  
4 multi-year procedure established by Section 3-414.1 of this  
5 Code.

6 (b) The design, color, and format of the plates shall be  
7 wholly within the discretion of the Secretary of State, except  
8 that the U.S. Marine Corps emblem shall appear on the plates.  
9 The Secretary may, in his or her discretion, allow the plates  
10 to be issued as vanity or personalized plates in accordance  
11 with Section 3-405.1 of this Code. The plates are not required  
12 to designate "Land Of Lincoln", as prescribed in subsection  
13 (b) of Section 3-412 of this Code. The Secretary shall  
14 prescribe the eligibility requirements and, in his or her  
15 discretion, shall approve and prescribe stickers or decals as  
16 provided under Section 3-412.

17 (c) An applicant shall be charged a \$5 fee for original  
18 issuance in addition to the applicable registration fee. This  
19 additional fee shall be deposited into the Marine Corps  
20 Scholarship Fund. For each registration renewal period, an \$18  
21 fee, in addition to the appropriate registration fee, shall be  
22 charged. This additional fee shall be deposited into the  
23 Marine Corps Scholarship Fund.

24 The Secretary of State shall waive any additional fees  
25 under this subsection if the individual requesting the license  
26 plate:

1           (1) requests that the additional fees be waived; and  
2           (2) is serving or has served in any branch of the  
3           United States Armed Forces, including the National Guard  
4           or other reserve components of the Armed Forces.

5           (d) The Marine Corps Scholarship Fund is created as a  
6 special fund in the State treasury. All moneys in the Marine  
7 Corps Scholarship Fund shall, subject to appropriation by the  
8 General Assembly and distribution by the Secretary, be used by  
9 the Marine Corps Coordinating Council of Illinois, Inc., a  
10 recognized charitable organization that meets the requirements  
11 of Title 26, Section 501(c)(3) of the United States Code, to  
12 provide grants for scholarships for higher education. The  
13 scholarship recipients must be the children of current or  
14 former members of the United States Marine Corps who meet the  
15 academic, financial, and other requirements established by the  
16 Marine Corps Scholarship Foundation. In addition, the  
17 recipients must be Illinois residents and must attend a  
18 college or university located within the State of Illinois.

19           (e) In addition, the Marine Corps Coordinating Council of  
20 Illinois is authorized to provide grants to the Marine Corps  
21 Scholarship Foundation, the Young Marine National Foundation,  
22 the Women Marines Association, and to any local chapter of the  
23 Marine Corps League that is located in Illinois. Any grant  
24 money paid from the Marine Corps Scholarship Fund shall be  
25 used for scholarships for undergraduate, graduate, and career  
26 and technical education and certification, financial

1 assistance, or monetary awards to veterans or veterans'  
2 families that are located within the State of Illinois.

5 Sec. 3-698. U.S. Air Force license plates.

6 (a) The Secretary, upon receipt of all applicable fees and  
7 applications made in the form prescribed by the Secretary of  
8 State, may issue special registration plates designated as  
9 U.S. Air Force license plates to residents of Illinois who  
10 meet eligibility requirements prescribed by the Secretary of  
11 State. The special plate issued under this Section shall be  
12 affixed only to passenger vehicles of the first division,  
13 motor vehicles of the second division weighing not more than  
14 8,000 pounds, and recreational vehicles as defined by Section  
15 1-169 of this Code. Plates issued under this Section shall  
16 expire according to the multi-year procedure established by  
17 Section 3-414.1 of this Code.

18 (b) The design, color, and format of the plates shall be  
19 wholly within the discretion of the Secretary of State, except  
20 that the U.S. Air Force emblem shall appear on the plates. The  
21 Secretary may, in his or her discretion, allow the plates to be  
22 issued as vanity or personalized plates in accordance with  
23 Section 3-405.1 of this Code. The plates are not required to  
24 designate "Land Of Lincoln", as prescribed in subsection (b)  
25 of Section 3-412 of this Code. The Secretary shall prescribe

1 the eligibility requirements and, in his or her discretion,  
2 shall approve and prescribe stickers or decals as provided  
3 under Section 3-412.

4 (c) An applicant shall be charged a \$20 fee for original  
5 issuance in addition to the applicable registration fee. Of  
6 this additional fee, \$15 shall be deposited into the Secretary  
7 of State Special License Plate Fund and \$5 shall be deposited  
8 into the Octave Chanute Aerospace Heritage Fund. For each  
9 registration renewal period, a \$20 fee, in addition to the  
10 appropriate registration fee, shall be charged. Of this  
11 additional fee, \$2 shall be deposited into the Secretary of  
12 State Special License Plate Fund and \$18 shall be deposited  
13 into the Octave Chanute Aerospace Heritage Fund.

14 The Secretary of State shall waive any additional fees  
15 under this subsection if the individual requesting the license  
16 plate:

- 17 (1) requests that the additional fees be waived; and  
18 (2) is serving or has served in any branch of the  
19 United States Armed Forces, including the National Guard  
20 or other reserve components of the Armed Forces.

21 (d) The Octave Chanute Aerospace Heritage Fund is created  
22 as a special fund in the State treasury. All moneys in the  
23 Octave Chanute Aerospace Heritage Fund shall be paid, subject  
24 to appropriation by the General Assembly and approval by the  
25 Secretary, as grants to the Rantoul Historical Society and  
26 Museum, or any other charitable foundation responsible for the

1 former exhibits and collections of the Chanute Air Museum, for  
2 operational and program expenses of the Chanute Air Museum and  
3 any other structure housing exhibits and collections of the  
4 Chanute Air Museum.

6 (625 ILCS 5/3-699.15)

7 Sec. 3-699.15. Coast Guard license plates.

8 (a) The Secretary, upon receipt of all applicable fees and  
9 applications made in the form prescribed by the Secretary of  
10 State, may issue special registration plates designated as  
11 U.S. Coast Guard plates. The special plates issued under this  
12 Section shall be affixed only to passenger vehicles of the  
13 first division or motor vehicles of the second division  
14 weighing not more than 8,000 pounds. Plates under this Section  
15 shall expire according to the multi-year procedure established  
16 by Section 3-414.1 of this Code.

17 (b) The design and color of the special plates shall be  
18 wholly within the discretion of the Secretary. Appropriate  
19 documentation, as determined by the Secretary, shall accompany  
20 each application.

21 (c) An applicant shall be charged a \$26 fee for the  
22 original issuance in addition to the appropriate registration  
23 fee, if applicable. Of this fee, \$11 shall be deposited into  
24 the Illinois Veterans' Homes Fund and \$15 shall be deposited  
25 into the Secretary of State Special License Plate Fund. For

1 each registration renewal period, a \$26 fee, in addition to  
2 the appropriate registration fee, shall be charged. Of this  
3 fee, \$24 shall be deposited into the Illinois Veterans' Homes  
4 Fund and \$2 shall be deposited into the Secretary of State  
5 Special License Plate Fund.

6 The Secretary of State shall waive any additional fees  
7 under this subsection if the individual requesting the license  
8 plate:

9 (1) requests that the additional fees be waived; and

10 (2) is serving or has served in any branch of the  
11 United States Armed Forces, including the National Guard  
12 or other reserve components of the armed forces.
