SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

Appropriates \$5,000,000 from the General Revenue Fund to the State Board of Education for a \$1,000,000 grant to the Chicago Board of Education each year for 5 years, subject to reappropriation by the General Assembly, for the Department of JROTC Leadership to update classroom equipment, purchase drum and bugle instruments, support a training facility, establish weekend training retreats, purchase uniforms and uniform accessories, provide drone and simulator training, support retired veteran staffing assistants, and host an end-of-the-year graduation banquet. Effective July 1, 2024.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented**
3 **in the General Assembly:**

4 Section 5. The sum of \$5,000,000, or so much of that sum
5 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue
6 Fund to the State Board of Education for a \$1,000,000 grant to
7 the Chicago Board of Education each year for 5 years, subject
8 to reappropriation by the General Assembly, for the Department
9 of JROTC Leadership to update classroom equipment, purchase
10 drum and bugle instruments, support a training facility,
11 establish weekend training retreats, purchase uniforms and
12 uniform accessories, provide drone and simulator training,
13 support retired veteran staffing assistants, and host an end-
14 of-the-year graduation banquet.

15 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect July 1,
