

## 103RD GENERAL ASSEMBLY State of Illinois 2023 and 2024 HB4706

Introduced 2/6/2024, by Rep. Jenn Ladisch Douglass and La Shawn K. Ford

## SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

20 ILCS 301/55-45 new 405 ILCS 5/5-100.1 new

Amends the Substance Use Disorder Act and the Mental Health and Developmental Disabilities Code. Provides that substance abuse programs and mental health or developmental disabilities facilities operating in the State shall provide verbal notice to the personal representative of the patient within 24 hours after the death of a patient and shall provide written notice to the personal representative of the patient within 5 days after the death of a patient. Effective immediately.

1 AN ACT concerning health.

## Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. The Substance Use Disorder Act is amended by adding Section 55-45 as follows:
- 6 (20 ILCS 301/55-45 new)
- 7 Sec. 55-45. Notice of death of patient. Any program operating in this State shall provide notice of the death of a 8 9 patient occurring in the program to the personal representative of the patient. The program shall provide 10 verbal notice to the personal representative of the patient 11 within 24 hours after the death of the patient and shall 12 provide written notice to the personal representative of the 13 14 patient within 5 days after the death of the patient. The program shall provide notice under this subsection in 15 accordance with 42 CFR 2.15(b) and 45 CFR 164.502(g), as 16 amended. For the purposes of this subsection, "personal 17 representative" has the meaning set forth in 45 CFR 18 19 164.502(g).
- 20 Section 10. The Mental Health and Developmental 21 Disabilities Code is amended by adding Section 5-100.1 as
- 22 follows:

1 (405 ILCS 5/5-100.1 new)

Sec. 5-100.1. Notice of death of patient. Any mental 2 3 health or developmental disabilities facility operating in 4 this State shall provide notice of the death of a recipient of 5 services occurring in the facility to the personal 6 representative of the recipient of services. The facility shall provide verbal notice to the personal representative of 7 8 the recipient of services within 24 hours after the death of 9 the recipient of services and shall provide written notice to 10 the personal representative of the recipient of services 11 within 5 days after the death of the recipient of services. The 12 facility shall provide notice under this subsection in 13 accordance with 42 CFR 2.15(b) and 45 CFR 164.502(g), as amended. For the purposes of this subsection, "personal 14 representative" has <u>the meaning set forth in 45</u> 15 CFR 16 164.502(g).

17 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect upon 18 becoming law.
