1 AMENDMENT TO HOUSE BILL 4903 2 AMENDMENT NO. . Amend House Bill 4903 by replacing everything after the enacting clause with the following: 3 "Section 5. The School Code is amended by adding Section 4 2-3.204 as follows: 5 6 (105 ILCS 5/2-3.204 new)7 Sec. 2-3.204. Air quality resources. The State Board of Education shall, in consultation with the Department of Public 8 Health, compile resources for elementary and secondary schools 9 10 relating to indoor air quality in schools, including best practices for assessing and maintaining ventilation systems 11

and information on any potential State or federal funding

sources that may assist a school in identifying ventilation

needs. The State Board of Education shall compile these

resources in consultation with stakeholders, including, but

not limited to, the Department of Public Health, local public

health professionals, ventilation professionals affiliated 1 2 with a Department of Labor apprenticeship program, licensed design professionals, representatives from regional offices of 3 4 education, school district administrators, teachers, or any 5 other relevant professionals, stakeholders, or representatives 6 of State agencies. No later than 30 days after resources are compiled under this Section, the State Board of Education 7 shall implement outreach strategies to make the compiled 8 9 resources available to elementary and secondary schools, 10 including publication of the compiled resources on the State Board of Education's website. The State Board of Education 11 may, in consultation with the Department of Public Health or 12 any other relevant stakeholders, update the compiled resources 13 14 as necessary.

Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect January
16 1, 2025.".
