

## 103RD GENERAL ASSEMBLY State of Illinois 2023 and 2024 HB5160

Introduced 2/9/2024, by Rep. Tony M. McCombie

## SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

820 ILCS 192/10

Amends the Paid Leave for All Workers Act. Provides that the definition of "employee" means an individual who (i) meets the definition of "employee" in specified provisions of the Illinois Wage Payment and Collection Act and (ii) works at least 195 hours for an employer over a period of at least 90 days.

## Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. The Paid Leave for All Workers Act is amended by changing Section 10 as follows:

- 7 Sec. 10. Definitions. As used in this Act:
- "Construction industry" means any constructing, altering, 8 9 reconstructing, repairing, rehabilitating, refinishing, refurbishing, remodeling, remediating, renovating, custom 10 fabricating, maintenance, landscaping, improving, wrecking, 11 painting, decorating, demolishing, or adding to or subtracting 12 13 from any building, structure, highway, roadway, street, 14 bridge, alley, sewer, ditch, sewage disposal plant, waterworks, parking facility, railroad, excavation or other 15 16 structure, project, development, real property, 17 improvement, or to do any part thereof, whether or not the performance of the work herein described involves the addition 18 19 to or fabrication into, any structure, project, development,
- "Construction industry" also includes moving construction related materials on the job site or to or from the job site,

real property, or improvement herein described of any material

- 1 snow plowing, snow removal, and refuse collection.
- 2 "Department" means the Illinois Department of Labor.
- 3 "Domestic work" and "domestic worker" have the same

meanings as defined in Section 10 of the Domestic Workers'

- 5 Bill of Rights Act, except that "domestic worker" also
- 6 includes independent contractors, sole proprietors, and
- 7 partnerships.

- 8 "Employee" means an individual who (i) meets the 9 definition of "employee" has the same application and meaning 10 as that provided in Sections 1 and 2 of the Illinois Wage 11 Payment and Collection Act and (ii) works at least 195 hours 12 for an employer over a period of at least 90 days. "Employee" 13 also includes all domestic workers, and, for the purposes of this Act, domestic workers shall not be excluded as employees 14 under the provisions of item (1), (2), or (3) of Section 2 of 15 16 the Illinois Wage Payment and Collection Act. "Employee" does 17 not include:
  - (1) an employee as defined in the federal Railroad Unemployment Insurance Act (45 U.S.C. 351 et seq.) or the Railway Labor Act;
  - (2) a student enrolled in and regularly attending classes in a college or university that is also the student's employer, and who is employed on a temporary basis at less than full time at the college or university, but this exclusion applies only to work performed for that college or university; or

(3) a short-term employee who is employed by an 1 2 higher education for institution of less than 2 consecutive calendar quarters during a calendar year and 3 who does not have a reasonable expectation that they will 4 5 be rehired by the same employer of the same service in a 6 subsequent calendar year.

"Employer" has the same application and meaning as that provided in Sections 1 and 2 of the Illinois Wage Payment and Collection Act, except that for purposes of this Act, "employer" also means the State and units of local government, any political subdivision of the State or units of local government, or any State or local government agency.

"Employer" does not include school districts organized under the School Code or park districts organized under the Park District Code.

"Writing" or "written" means a printed or printable communication in physical or electronic format, including a communication that is transmitted through electronic mail, text message, or a computer system or is otherwise sent or stored electronically.
