1 AMENDMENT TO HOUSE BILL 5289 2 AMENDMENT NO. . Amend House Bill 5289 by replacing everything after the enacting clause with the following: 3 "Section 5. The Department of Human Services Act is 4 5 amended by adding Section 1-41 as follows: 6 (20 ILCS 1305/1-41 new)7 Sec. 1-41. Community-based mental health and substance use professionals; coverage for client-centered consultation. The 8 Department of Human Services shall reimburse community-based 9 10 mental health and substance use professionals for hours spent providing client-centered consultation when it occurs with a 11 12 licensed practitioner of the healing arts as defined in 89 13 Ill. Adm. Code 140.453(b)(3). As used in this Section, "community-based mental health and substance use professional" 14

has the same meaning ascribed to that term in Section 5-52 of

the Illinois Public Aid Code.

- Section 10. The Illinois Public Aid Code is amended by 1 adding Section 5-52 as follows: 2

- Sec. 5-52. Community-based mental health and substance use 4
- professionals; coverage for client-centered consultation. 5
- (a) As used <u>in this Section</u>, <u>"community-based mental</u> 6
- 7 health and substance use professional" means a licensed
- 8 practitioner of the healing arts as defined in 89 Ill. Adm.
- 9 Code 140.453(b)(3).
- (b) The medical assistance program, including both the 10
- 11 fee-for-service and managed care medical assistance programs
- 12 established under this Article, shall reimburse
- 13 community-based mental health and substance use professionals
- 14 for hours spent providing client-centered consultation when it
- occurs with a licensed practitioner of the healing arts. The 15
- Department shall amend 89 Ill. Adm. Code 140.453 to allow 16
- client-centered consultation when it occurs with a licensed 17
- 18 practitioner of the healing arts to be a covered service in
- 19 accordance with the provisions of this subsection.
- (c) By January 1, 2025, the Department shall submit to the 20
- Joint Committee on Administrative Rules a rulemaking proposal 21
- 22 to implement this Section as soon as practicable.
- Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect upon 23
